this Day Being with heavy gales from the
W^W and foggy weather and steering E by S
per compass up a heavy sea running and
all sail set kept under way at 1 PM
Double Reefed the main top sail and took
in the St. Boat and 2 Ships in Site
middle part Moderate gales latter
part Win from the S^W and steering
E by S per compass all sail set and one Day
in Site to End the Day

the S^W with Cloudy weather and steering
E by S all sail set and 3 men Sick of Duty
and 2 Ships in Site at 1 PM spoke them

weather and 3 Ships in Site to End the

Remarks on Board Tuesday October the 21

this Day Being with Light Breezes from
W^W and Cloudy weather and one Ship in
Site at 2 PM spoke the Ship Haman of
New Bedford 2000 blles at 10 and steering
E by S all sail set and 4 men Sick of Duty
middle part the Win' carried to Eastward
and heading S by E per compass at 3 PM
Double Reefed the top sail latter part fresh
gales and Smoky together and Close Reefed
the fore and main top sail and took in the
main sail and Loh to End these 24 hours

this Day Being with Fresh gales from the
E by S and Rain weather and Lay in to under
a Double Reefed main top sail and Fore sail at
1 PM Close Reefed the main top sail and took

part moderate winds from the S by E and all
sail set and thick foggy weather and heading
per compass N by E to End these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Friday October the 24

this Day Being with Light winds from
the S by E with thick foggy weather and
a heavy swell on and heading per compass
S by E all sail set and 4 men Sick of
Duty and the Watch employed steering
at Day Head middle part fresh breezes
and Rain weather and heading E by N latter
part Wind carried to the N^W and thick
foggy weather and steering S by N per
compass all sail set to End the Day
