of on in At Honolulu

Remarks on Board Tuesday December the 2 then
Commenced with light winds being off Honolulu
Sent a boat on shore mid light winds and
Calms later rain so ends this 24 ours

Wednesday December 3 Wednesday

This Commenced with light winds and Calms 1st AM
Sent a boat on shore at 6 AM returned brought 2
Men Peter and Thomas when mid light winds and
Rain later the same boat on shore Laying off Honolulu
to ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Thursday December the 4 This
Commenced with light wind and rain from
N.E. Laying off Honolulu sent a boat on shore
At 6 AM returned with the Captain and 3 men
Ship in Honolulu John McQueen's benign
Lieut H Bailey 6 AM started light winds
mid light the same later strong winds from
N steering E & E stowed the uncovers tack in the
Starboard boat for repair so ends 24 ours

Remarks on Board Friday December the 5
this day Commenced with strong winds from N.E.
Steering S.E. all sail set mid light S.E. by S.E.
later steering by the wind 7 PM tack in and
Doubled reefed the topsails the watch im-
ployed in ships duty so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on Board Saturday December the 6
this day Commenced with strong and squalls
from E by N under 2 reef topsails edging to
the S mid light the mainsail and jib later
Strong breezes set the mainsail and jib steering by
the wind edging to the S by E so ends 24 ours
the watch employed in ships duty so ends this 24

Remarks on Board Sunday December the 7 This
Day Commenced with strong winds and squalls
from E by N steering by the wind under 2 reef
topsails larboard tack on board 1 sail in sight 2
Men at duty sick mid light strong winds and
very squalls later the same 5 PM started the
Fore topsail in a squall sent it down
and sent a new topsail the steward returned
to duty the watch employed in ships duty
so ends this 24 ours
