Remarks on board Monday December the 8
This day commenced with strong winds from
the ESE ship under 2 reef topsails steering
ESE midel strong strong breezes later strong
breezes and squalls steering SE by S under 2
Reef topsails put out the starboard bote
Carpenter fitting a new bote the watch
employed in ships duty so ends this 24 ours
Lat 9.46 Lon 156.03

Remarks on board Tuesday December the 9
Commenced with strong winds from ESE steering
by ESE under 2 reef topsails midel the wind
later very rain squalls steering by the wind
edging varies forces so ends this 24 ours
Lat 7.59 Long 156

Remarks on board Wednesday December the 10
This day commenced with light winds and
squalls at rain from SE steering by the
Wind edging SE by E let the reefs out of
the topsails and set the main top gale sail
put out a new mast bote stuck in the
Carboard bote for repair repairing a gill
midel strong breezes from ESE steering SE by E
1 pen stuck in the main top gale sail and
put 1 reef in the topsails later strong
breezes and cloudy the watch employed
for ships duty so ends this 24 ours
Latitude 6.16 Long 157.36

Remarks on board Thursday December 11
This day commenced with strong winds from
E and cloudy 1 pen put 2 reefs in the topsails
and stoad the mainsail 6 Am close reef
the fore and main topsails down to the Sea
Leaving midel moderated later set a
Reef mainsail strong breezes and clear
Weather the watch employed in repa-
ring a fore topsail so ends this 24 ours
Lat 4.49 Lon 156.16

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Remarks on board Friday December the 12
This day commenced with strong breezes from ESE
steering by the wind to the S 2 Am let the
reefs out of the topsails 6 Am set top gale sails
fine pleasant weather midel light winds and
pleasant weather later light winds and
And cloudy 6 pm sent down the foresail
for repair and bent a new foresail the
Watch employed in repairing sails so
ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Saturday December the 13
This day commenced with light winds and
And cloudy from E steering light wind
edging to the S all sail set later
fresh breezes and squally 11 Am raised land
distance 4 miles to the south latched ship sailing
to ESE 3 pm latched ship edging ESE all
sail set later strong breezes and squally
1 sail in sight 11 pm raised the land
distance 6 miles from Crismes ile running
along the land the men employed in ships
duty so ends this 24 ours
Latitude 1.29 Longitude 158.24

Remarks on board Sunday December the 14
This commenced with strong winds and squally
from E by N edging SE by E all sail set 1 Am
land out of sight midel fresh breezes and
breezy squalls later fine breezes and
pleasant weather from the E edging by the
Wind to E by S all sail set
the men employed in ships duty
so ends this 24 ours
