Remarks on board Saturday December the 27
this day commenced with a strong breeze
from the E to SSE and rain steering
S by E all sail set set up the jib
and flying jib stays midel light
winds and variable and a rain storm
later light winds from the SSE
S by E all sail set thick rain storm
the blacksmith employed in repairing
the winless so ends this 24 ours.

Remarks on board Sunday December the 28
this day commenced with light
winds from the SSE and rain
steering S by E all sail set the
men employed in mending hale midel
Wind alling to the S and rain later
Strong breeze from the S eding to the SE by E
6 pm tack in top galsails thick and
rain 8 pm put 2 reefs in the topsails
the watch employed in ships duty
so ends this 24 ours

Latitude 27° 15

Remarks on board Monday December the 29

this day commenced with strong wind
from the S eding by the wind starboard
tacks at board under 2 reef topsails 7 Am
the rain alling to the W eding SE by S
later strong breeze from the SSE steering
by the wind eding SE 8 pm let the reefs
out of the topsails set the main top
galsails the men employed in
ships duty so ends this 24 ours

Ship onward bound 8 December the 1856

Remarks on board Tuesday December the 30
this day commenced with a fine breeze and
pleasant weather from the SSE steering by the
Wind to SE starboard at board set up the flying
jib gyes and filing the rizen Carpenter repairing
the blacksmith employed at making gaffs
And jibs midel light winds light and pleasant
Weather later wind alled to the south by E
5 pm tacked ship seawest by W the
men employed at filing and repairing
rizen so ends this 24 ours

Latitude 31° 19

Remarks on board Wednesday December the 31
this commenced with light winds from the
S by E and fine pleasant weather eding to
S by W all sail set filing the fore and
main rizen 7 Am wind alled to the S by W by
S tacked ship eding SE starboard tacked at board
midel light winds and Calms 10 pm tacked
eding 10 pm later 12 pm sent the fore top
galsail for repair the men employed at
various gobs so ends this 24 ours

Latitude 31° 45 Longitude 178° 38

Remarks on board Thursday January the 1

this day commenced with light winds and
Calms 2 Am a light breeze from the E
steering S all sail set 4 Am sent up
the fore top galsail and bent it
sent down the main no bent topsail and
bent bent the jib bent the old ones
midel light winds later light winds
and cloudy weather spaining the main
And mizenmast employed in various
gobs so ends this 24 ours
