Wind to the S.S.W. all sail set the
men employed in various gobs so
ends this 24 ours

and fine pleasant weather from the
S.E. edging by the wind to S.S.W. lashed
Tacks of board all sail set painted
A tote over shed Carpenter fitting the
Wheelless fitting the rigging and fresh
Breeze of wind from the S.E. by E edging by the W
midday light winds later light winds
from the E.S.E. steering S by E all sail
set. rive new main braces and main top
sail braces rive the old ones fore the
men employed in various gobs so ends
this 24 ours latitude 35°17 longitude 160°27

the men employed in various gobs
so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Tuesday January the 6

this day commenced with light winds and
pleasant weather the wind vary from E to N.E.
steering S by E est employed in fitting rigging
midday light winds later light winds
and variable from E.S.E. to N. steering
S by E all sail set to the best advantage
saw grampses the men employed
in various gobs all ends well
so ends this 24 ours

latitude 39°53 N longitude 159°56 W

Remarks on board January 7 Wednesday the 7

this day commenced with light winds and
pleasant weather from the N.E. steering
S.E. all sail set fitting the cooking stove
6 am struck and got 2 porpoises on board
midday light winds later strong breeze from
the off steering S.E. all sail set to the
best advantage 8 pm sent down the masts
for repair the men employed in various
gobs all ends well so ends this 24 ours
latitude 42°02 longitude 160°00 W
