

Ship onward bound. 1 January 1857

Remarks on board Thursday January the 8

this day commenced with strong breeze of wind from the N. steering S. E. All sail set. thick and icy repairing the mainsail 4 am finished the mainsail sent it up and bent it. 6 am steered S. E. Saw a school of black fish saw jumpers midell strong breeze and rain from the N. 10 am tack in. top gale sails. 11 am put 2 Reefs in the topsails breezing on. later wind falling to the S. W. thick fog 8 pm tack in the fore and misen topsails blowing a gale over the under dubbell reef main topsail and foresail eding S. E. starboard tack at board all ends well so ends this 24 ours latitude 44° 15' S. longitude 160° 10' W

Remarks on board Friday January the 9

this day commenced a gale of wind from the S. W. eding S. W. over the under the fore sail and dubbell reef main topsail 1 am moderating set the fore and misen topsails dubbell reef at 2 set the gill cleer weather 6 am moderating under E. say sail. midell strong breeze the wind edd to the W. N. W. steering S. W. by S later wind S. W. eding by the wind to S. E. under single reef topsails the men employed in ships duty all ends well so ends this 24 ours

latitude 46° 35' N longitude 160° 13' W

Remarks on board Saturday January the 10

this day commenced with a strong wind from the S. W. eding by the wind to S. E. under single reef topsails and fores 7 am tack in sail expecting to go to sea in the morning midell light winds 11 am raised at sea it was ship eding to the N. later light winds from the N. 4 pm spoke ship new eng land at stem under 5 miles this seen 5 pm steered S. E. by S 11 raised and the boats all ends well so ends this 24 ours

Ship onward Cruising South January 1857

Remarks on board Sunday January the 11

this day commenced with a strong breeze from the W. the boats after wake 4 past 12. larboard boat struck 3 am tack the water to the ship 5 am commenced to cut breezing on and raged tack a flip and stopped cutting very raged midell a gale close reef the main topsail stood the foresail 2 pm moderated 6 pm commenced cutting wore ship and cut to board 10 pm breezing on so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Monday January the 12

this day commenced with a strong breeze of wind from the W. N. W. blowing on to a gale cutting the main 1 am finished cutting the W. made all secure 4 am blowing a gale of wind 10 rain 11 moderating midell rain later strong breeze and a very sea lying to N. set the foresail eding to the N. larboard tack a board so ends this 24 ours

latitude 46° 41' S longitude 158° 26' W

Remarks on board Tuesday January the 13

this day commenced with a strong breeze and a very sea in a very sea cleaning house 1 am steered S. E. let 1 reef out of the main topsail set the fore topsail dubbell reef and gill 2 am commenced hoisting midell rain later breeze from the S. W. eding S. E. under dubbell reef main topsail all ends in a very sea in hoisting so ends this 24 ours
