Remarks on board Wednesday January the 14.
this day commenced with strong breeze
from the S.W. aided by the wind to
S.E. thick and rain employed in
hoisting 2 A.M. the wind falling to
the N. by E. close reef the main topsail
breeing on to a gale midell a gale
later blowing very cold down the works
were ship riding to the N. thened up the
starboard boat 15 Casks of oil on deck
so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Thursday January the 15.
this day commenced with a gale of
wind from the W. ve the under close
reef main topsail blowing very cold
tacks on board 2 A.M. blowing on very
and very squalls 5 A.M. moderated
midell moderate gale very squalls
later the same very sea running
turned down the starboard boat
so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Friday January the 16.
this day commenced with moderate
gale of wind and very squalls from
the S.W. ve the under close reef
main topsail 2 A.M. a breeze of and
stared E. N. E. & bluffed to starboard
tacks of board midell moderated later
blowing of moderate gale and very squalls
7 pm started the works 10 pulled down
breeing in and very squalls
so ends this 24 ours
Lat 46° 19' Lon 154° 46'

Ship onward Cruising south January 1857

Remarks on board Sunday January the 17
this day commenced with a gale of
wind from the S.W. and very squalls
ve the under close reef main topsail
starboard tacks of board riding to N. N. W.
midell moderating very sea later light breeze
set the fore and main topsails. Subell
reef 7 pm started the day works to hoist
8 pm were ship riding to the S.W. starboard
tacks of board so ends this 24 ours
Latitude 46° 26' S Longitude 154° 57' W

Remarks on board Sunday 1 January the 18
this day commenced with light winds
and squalls from the W. by N. riding
by the wind to the S.W. under such hell
reef topsails starboard tacks of board employed
in hoisting 9 A.M. pulled down the works
finished hoisting out the main midell
rain later light winds and Calms spoke
barque midward of fore and main masts they
seven 2 pm light breeze from the S.E.
riding by the wind to the S.W. all
sail so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Monday January the 19
this day commenced with light winds
and pleasant weather from the S.E. all
sail set steering by the wind to the
S.W. starboard tacks of board 24 Casks of
oil on deck bark midward in sight
midell light winds later light winds
and pleasant weather riding by the wind
to S.W. 6 pm raised a mile going to the
S.W. quick shot not bore 7 pm broke out
the hole in the main atches to set down
oil bark in sight so ends this 24 ours
Latitude 47° 08' S Longitude 155° 59' W
