this day commenced with light winds and
pleasant weather from the S.E. edging by the
wind to the S.W. all sail set employed
in stowing down oil in the mainatches 3 Am
raised a maul going quick sundown tack in
light sails middle light winds and calms
later light breeze from the N. edging by
the wind to the W. all sail set the
men employed in braking out the between
deck so ends this 24 hrs
Latitude 47 28 S Longitude 156 55 W

Remarks on board Wednesday January the 21
this day commenced with light winds and
pleasant weather from the N. edging by the
wind to the W. all sail set employed in
braking out the between decks 4 Am raised a
did maul a shed tack in a long side
5 Am commenced cutting tack the shed
A board at 8 lashed down for the night
middle strong breeze and rain later light
breeze and thick weather 6 pm commenced
cutting 2 part 10 finished cutting 11 hoisting
the oil running out of the bilboes fast
so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Thursday January the 22
this day commenced with a strong breeze
from the N.E. thick cloudy weather
steering W by S under double reef
main topsail and foresail 2 Am rain
belled down the masts 5 wind altered
to W S W. breezing on 7 close reefed
the main topsail 10 modrotted started
the by masts middle in wind edging to the
N. later thick and cloudy weather
short sail hoisting so ends this
24 hrs Latitude 47 50 S Longitude 158 11 W

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Remarks on board Friday January the 23
this day commenced with a light breeze of wind
from the N. and thick cloudy weather ship edging
to S.W. all sail set 3 Am finished hoisting
40 bbls of oil on deck sundown fresh breeze middle
light winds and calms later rain 10 light
breeze from the W N W. and edging to
the S.W. steering N.E. all sail set
the men employed washing ship so
ends this 24 hrs
Latitude 47 22 S Longitude 159 18 W

Remarks on board Saturday January 24
this day commenced with a fresh breeze
from the W N W. edging by the wind
to the N. all sail set employed in
washing ship 3 Am raised mauls a keel
4 Am leard mast hove struck and
tack in to the ship tack in all
sail sundown saw several whales middle light
winds and rain later strong breeze from the
W employed in cutting the maul 10 finished
cutting maul sail saw several sperm
sail in sight edging to S.E. so ends this
24 hrs Latitude 47 19 S Longitude 159 45 W

Remarks on board Sunday January the 25
this day commenced with fresh breeze from
the W. heeling to starboard after whales
saw 1 right whale several sperm in sight
going quick 3 Am commenced hoisting
sundown tack in sail strong breeze with
squally middle calm later 4 pm rain
and strong breeze from the S.E. 8 breezing
on 8 pm close reefed the main topsail
tack in the fore sail over in edging
to S.W. 10 belled down the masts
Latitude 47 27 S Longitude 159 44 W
