

Ship onward bound to the North february 1857

Remarks on board Saturday february the 7
 this day commenced with strong breeze
 from the E. N. E. thick and cloudy squally
 All sail set eding to the N. W. 2 A tuck
 in top galsails bresing on 4 dubbell
 reefed the topsails stowed the mainsail
 and gik bresing on and evy squalls
 Midell giv squalls 10 tuck in the fore and
 misen topsails later moderated made
 sail to dubbell reef topsails 8 pm
 bresing on thick and rainy 9 wore ship
 eding N. E. wind allied to the N. N. W.
 so ends this 24 ours
 latitude 42° 22' S

Remarks on board Sunday february the 8
 this day commenced with a strong breeze
 from of wind from the N. N. W.
 eding to N. E. ship under dubbell reef
 topsails 3 A m tuck in the gik and span
 cor 6 close reefed the fore topsail bresing
 on squally thick rainy 9 A m tuck in the
 fore and misen topsails blowing a moderate
 gale later calm thick fog and rain
 9 pm light breeze from S. E. made all
 sail and steered N. by W. thick
 weather so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Monday february the 9
 this day commenced with light winds
 and thick fog and rain steering N. by E
 All sail set wind gradually falling
 to the E. 4 A m wind allied to the N.
 ship eding W. by N. 6 tacked ship eding
 E. N. E. strong breeze thick fog tuck in
 fore and misen topsails midell
 strong breeze thick fog later strong breeze thick
 fog 6 pm tacked ship eding W. N. W.
 strong breeze so ends this 24 ours

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Remark on board Tuesday february the 10
 this day commenced with strong breeze of wind
 from the N. eding by the wind to W. N. W.
 thick fog making scrubbing brown teeth 5
 bresing on dubbell reefed the topsails 8 A m
 tuck in the mainsail stowed it midell calm
 later clear wether calm evy swell from
 the south broke out in the after hole
 And slowed down south waughter to green
 Ship so ends this 24 ours

Remark on board february Wednesday the 11
 this day commenced with a calm clear
 wether imployed in glaving of the after
 hole 2 A m light breeze of wind from the
 E steering N. by W. all sail set midell
 strong breeze thick fog 12 wind allied to
 the N. N. E. tacked ship eding to N. W. by
 W. 4 pm tacked ship eding to N. E. by E thick
 fog and rain storm wind N. N. W. strong breeze
 tuck in top galsails so ends this
 24 ours

Remarks on board Thursday february the 12
 this day commenced with a strong breeze
 from the N. N. W. under topsails and corces
 thick fog and rain storm imployed in washing
 ship in side midell 10 wind allied to the
 south thick and cloudy made all sail
 And steered N. by W. later part strong
 breeze and clear wether set topmast
 stunsail painted the main ryal yard
 repaired the main ryal the men imployed
 in varcoys gals. so ends this 24 ours
 lat 38° 30' long 145° 02' W.
