

Ship onward North of the line March 18th 1857

Remarks on board Sunday March the 15th
this day commenced with a strong
breeze from N.E. to E. ship edging by
the wind N.N.W. to N. Clear pleasant
weather what hole middell strong
breeze tack in the main topgalsail
and flying gib latter strong
breeze and pleasant weather edging
by the wind to the N. wind E.N.E.
Set the main topgalsail and
flying gib so ends this 24 hrs
lat 8 miles N long 149.47 W

Remarks on board Monday March the 16th
this day commenced with strong
breeze and pleasant weather from
the E.N.E. steering N.N.W. all
sail set saw several fin back
middell strong breeze latter strong
breeze and squalls from the E.
All sail set set topmast stunsail
steering N.N.W. the men employed
in various jobs so ends this
24 hrs lat 313.2 N long 150.10 W

Remarks on board Tuesday March the 17th
this day commenced with strong breeze
and pleasant weather from the E. steering
N.N.W. all sail set middell strong
breeze and very squalls close reefed the
topgails latter the same 1 sail in sight
so ends this 24 hrs lat 6.14

Remarks on board Wednesday March the 18th
this day commenced with strong breeze
and very squalls ship under close reefed
topgails steering N.N.W. split the gib
middell rain latter set dubbell reefed
topgails so ends this 24 hrs lat 8.66 long 151.44

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Remarks on board Thursday March the 19th

this day commenced with strong breeze and
rain from the E.N.E. ship under dubbell reefed
topgails edging to the N. starboard tacks a board
7 Am following a gale of wind tack in sail
to dubbell reef main topgail fore and main
spencers one in middell and latter the same
so ends this 24 hrs lat 9.24 N long 152.17 W

Remarks on board Friday March the 20th
this day commenced with a moderate gale
of wind from the E.N.E. ship under close
reefed topgails on the starboard tacks
working to the N. middell strong breeze set
one reef out of the topgails latter moderate
made all sail pleasant weather the men
employed in various jobs so ends this 24 hrs
lat 11.34 N long 152.52 W

Remarks on board Saturday March the 21st
commenced with strong breeze and pleasant
weather from the E.N.E. ship edging by the
wind on the starboard tack all sail set working
to the N. repairing the gib middell strong breeze
latter the same the men employed in various
jobs so ends this 24 hrs lat 14.06 N long 152.47 W

Remarks on board Sunday March the 22nd
commenced with strong breeze and pleasant
weather from the E.N.E. edging by the wind
to the N. all sail set what hole 6 Am
light winds and variable middell wind
E.N.E. steering N.N.W. latter the same the
men employed in ships duty so ends this 24
hrs lat 16.54 N long 153.01 W

Remarks on board Monday March the 23rd
commenced with a fresh breeze from the
E.N.E. steering N.N.W. by W. all sail
set pleasant weather middell light
winds latter the same employed
in various jobs late tacked the chase
relucts repairing the gib pointing
bleaks so ends this 24 hrs
lat 10.26 N long 153.52 W
