Remarks on board Sunday April the 5th
Commenced with light and pleasant weather from
the S off manululu & late on shore 7
ships lying off the arbor middell
and latter the same so ends this
24 ours

Remarks on board Monday April the 6th
Commenced with light winds from
the south lying off manululu arbor
the middell and latter the same
so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Tuesday April the 7th
Commenced with light winds and
pleasant weather the middell and
latter the same so ends this
24 ours

Remarks on board Wednesday April the 8th
This commenced with light winds and
pleasant weather off manululu arbor
repaired the fore sail put on a
new fut rope middell light winds
and calms latter strong trades several
ships off the arbor so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Thursday April the 9th
Commenced with strong trades and
pleasant weather off manululu arbor
6 Am squared the yards and steered
W S W middell N W W latter made
after steered W so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Friday April the 10th
This commenced with strong trade
winds steering S S W for atter
8 Am hauled A back land distance 5
mills middell light winds and
calms latter light breeze from the
N E sent A boat on shore to trade
so ends this 24 ours

Ship onward bound to Goddard April 11th

Remarks on board Saturday April the 11th
This day commenced with light winds and
calms lying off one how boat on shore
to trade 4 Am but returned with A load
of eggs 6 Am returned on shore 6 returned
with eggs potatoes yams and fowls brased
the yards and steered to the W middell
light winds and variables eding in the wind
on various tacks latter wind N E eding
by the wind N N W all sail set sheet the
Anchors and Chains so ends this 24 ours
lat 22 23 N long 161 02 W

Remarks on board Sunday April the 12th
Commenced with light winds from the N E
eding by the wind to N N W all sail set
sheet hauled middell light winds and variables
latter south E steering N E by N all sail
set sheet fin back so ends this 24 ours lat 23 55 N

Remarks on board Monday April the 13th
Commenced with light winds and pleasant weather
from the S steering N E by N all sail set 4 Am
load for black fish but without success mid
dell light winds latter strong breeze from
S S W employed in repairing the main topsail
so ends this 24 ours lat 24 56 N

Remarks on board Tuesday April the 14th
Commenced with strong breeze from the S S W
and squally steering N E by N all
sail set repairing the main topsail
middell strong breeze tack in top galsails
dubbell reef the topsails latter pressing
on close reef the topsails 11 pm tuck in the
fore and main topsails and luffed to
the wind blowing a gale at wind 1 sail
in sight so ends this 24 ours lat 27 42 long 15 20

Remarks on board Wednesday April the 15th
Commenced with a gale of wind from the W
are to under close reef main topsail and
foresail eding to the N 6 Am set fore and
main topsails 1 sail in sight middell steered
N by E latter the same repairing the main
top galsail so ends this 24 ours
lat 29 06 long
