

Ship onward bound to Godaack April 1857

Remarks on board Thursday April the 16th

Commenced with strong breeze and clear weather from the W under dubbell reef topsails and foremast repaired the main topgallensail bent it & singell reef topsails and main topgallensail steering N by E middle dubbell reef latter singell topsails fore and main topgallensails the men employed in various jobs so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 31° 01' Long 155° 00' W

Remarks on board Friday April the 17th

Commenced with strong breeze from the S W and every squally steering N under singell reef topsails and top galle sails 1 sail in sight 6 AM tuck in top galle sails close reef the main topsail middle strong breeze and rain latter wind veered to the N eding by wind to the W starboard tacks A board race 1 new fore brace rove new lashings to the buting pennants so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 33° 18' N

Remarks on board Saturday April the 18th

Commenced with strong breeze and squally and rain from the N eding by the wind to the W 1 AM tacked ship eding N by E wind alling to the Westward dubbell reef the topsails middle squally latter wind W steering N made all sail moderating 1 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 34° 01'

Remarks on board Sunday April the 19th

Commenced with light winds and variable squally steering N by E sail set middle rain latter wind E rain so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 36° 03' Long 155° 15' W

Remarks on board Monday April the 20th

Commenced with strong breeze from the N eding on the wind starboard tacks a board the wind alling to the W 6 AM tacked ship eding N by E wind N by W squally tuck in light sails middle blowing a gale of wind latter the same under close reef main topsail so ends this 24 hrs Lat 36° 27'

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Remarks on board Tuesday April the 21st

Commenced with a moderate gale of wind from the N over under close reefed main top sail moderating set the fore sail 2 AM set fore and main topsail close reef middle light winds and calms latter light wind from the E made all sail and steered N sent down the main topgallensail for repair so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 36° 23' N

Remarks on board Wednesday April the 22nd

Commenced with a strong breeze and pleasant weather from the E steering N all sail set sent up and bent the main topgallensail 6 AM wind SE middle pressing on latter dubbell reef the topsails 10 Close reef blowing a gale if wind thick fog & mud rain so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Thursday April the 23rd

Commenced with a gale of wind from SE and rain steering N under close reef topsails 6 AM wind alling to the W in a squall blowing every tuck in all sail to close reef again topsail over eding to N by W middle moderate sea fore reef topsails latter all sail set wind S W steering N by W the men employed in ships duty so ends this 24 hrs Lat 41° 46' N

Remarks on board Friday April the 24th

Commenced with strong breeze and pleasant weather from the S W steering N by W all sail set middle light winds from the W latter the same sun fair back the men employed in ships duty so ends this 24 hrs Lat 44° 38' N

Remarks on board Saturday April the 25th

Commenced with strong breeze from the S steering N by W all sail set middle and rain strong breeze what hale the steward sick off duty the men employed in ships duty so ends this 24 hrs Lat 47° 51' N
