Ship on ward Bound to Codack Aprill

Remarks on board Sunday Aprill the 26th this commenced with strong breeze thick fog and rain storm from the S steering N by W 1/2 W all sail set 6 Am steered N 1/2 W breezing on S duhhel reef the topsails middell moderating latter made all sail light winds from S W steering N 1/2 W thick fog the men employed in ships duty so ends this 24 ours lat 50° 38' N

Remarks on board Monday Aprill the 27th this commenced with light winds and cloudy weather from S W steering N 1/2 W all sail set saw finbacks middell strong breeze thick fog latter the same wind I steered off duty sick so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Tuesday Aprill the 28th commenced with strong breeze from the South thick fog all sail set steering N 1/2 W 4 Am tuck in sail to duhhel reef main topsail luffed to the wind eding S W middell strong breeze latter moderate made all sail and steered N by W clear weather the wind all ed to S E finbacks in sight so ends this 24 ours lat 54° 04' N long 150° 54' W

Remarks on board Wednesday Aprill the 29th this commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather from S E all sail set steering N by W severell finbacks in sight 7 Am tuck in sail to duhhel reef main topsail breezing on middell Agall latter the same over eding N 1/2 E

Remarks on board Thursday Aprill the 30th this commenced with a gale of wind from S E gradually alling to the S thick fog and rain middell wind S S W eding S E blowing every latter moderating where ship eding W S W lardard larks saw finbacks so ends this 24 ours lat 55° 40' N long 149° 34' W

Ship on ward Cruising on Codack May 1st 1857

Remarks on board Friday May the 1st this commenced with a moderate gale of wind from S S W eding W S W lardard larks 1 Am where ship eding S E lardard larks a herd set the fore sail severell finbacks in sight saw 1 right whale 1 sail in sight middell light winds and calms latter light breeze from S E steering N 1/2 E spoke harquei president of green port so ends this 24 ours lat 55° 31' N long 149° 11' W

Remarks on board Saturday May the 2nd this commenced with light winds from S E pleasant weather steering N 1/2 E 7 Am tuck in sail middell light winds latter strong breeze thick weather 6 pm raised walles lard bow lute struck 10 but from in sight severell wales in sight 1 sail in sight so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Sunday May the 3rd this commenced with strong breeze and thick weather from S E walles in sight duhhel reefed the topsails 4 Am tuck in fore and misen topsails eding to S E 7 where ship eding to S thick fog light wind middell moderate gale latter the same so ends this 24 ours

Remarks on board Monday May the 4th this commenced with strong breeze thick fog and rain where ship eding to N 1/2 E 6 Am reft main topsail and foresail 7 Am where ship to the S moderating middell light winds thick cloudy weather latter fresh breeze lard for whales without success so ends this 24 ours lat 55° 55' N long 147° 51' W

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 5th this commenced with light winds and pleasant weather from S E all sail set 2 ships in sight lard for whales saw severell finbacks sundown tuck in sail calm middell calm latter light breeze from S W steering N 1/2 E by E all sail set 5 pm lard for 1 right whale going quick 1 ship in sight so ends this 24 ours lat 56° 08' N long 146° 52' W
