Remarks on board Wednesday May the 6th this
commenced with light winds from S^W
steering S^W by E all sail set saw
sum finback rose new fore topsail braces
1 main topsail hunting 7 tuck in sail
middell light winds latter fog by
spells saw finbacks so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Thursday May the 7th this
commenced with light wind from
S^W steering S^W by E fog by spells
2 Am board for right whale & placed
for right whale without success
repaired the main spencer tuck in sail
at sundown middell light breeze
latter light wind and fog by spells
board for whales 3 times without
success so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 56°42' N Long 143°22' W

Remarks on board Friday May the 8th this
commenced with light winds and
pleasant weather from S^W steering
N by E all sail set saw several
finbacks middell light winds steering
N latter strong breeze from E by E all
sail set plenty finbacks in sight
so ends this 24 hrs Lat 57°45' N Long 141°47' W

Remarks on board Saturday May the 9th this
commenced with strong breeze and thick
cloudy weather saw several finback
Sundown tuck in sail latter calm middell
calm latter light breeze from the E 3
pm land in sight distance 40 miles 6
pm wind to the N ship edging by the wind
starboard tack saw grampus so ends this
24 hrs Lat 58°40' N Long 142°18' W

Remarks on board Sunday May the 10th this
commenced with strong breeze from the
W steering S all sail set land in sight
A strong middell calm latter strong breeze
from S E saw finbacks 11 pm board for right
whale & placed for right whale but
and of such the whale slight down so ends
24 hrs

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Remarks on board Monday May the 11th this

commenced with strong breeze from S E edging
by the wind to S W starboard tucks 2 sail in
sight plenty of finbacks in sight 1 dubhell
reft the topsails 4 tuck in to close reefed
main topsail blowing on thick fog middell
the same latter light winds and calm 1 sail in
sight saw a number of finbacks in sight so
ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 12th this
commenced with light wind and calm
1 sail in sight several finbacks 7 tuck in
sail middell calm latter strong breeze from
W by W snow and all squalls edging by the wind
to the S all sail set the men employed in
ships duty so ends this 24 hrs Lat 56°49' N Long 144°30' W

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 13th this
commenced with strong breeze from W by W
squally saw several finbacks 7 tuck in sail
to dubhell reef topsails edging to the S middell
strong breeze latter the same under dubhell reef topsails
several finbacks backs in sight 3 men sick of duty
so ends this 24 hrs Lat 55°25' N Long 145°07' W

Remarks on board Thursday May the 14th this
commenced with strong breeze from the W by W
thick cloudy weather edging by the wind to the
South 1 Am where ship edging to S W starboard
tucks under dubhell reef topsails middell wind
filled to S E cleared W by W made sail latter
breezing on wind E by E 10 pm dubhell reft
the topsails 11 tuck in fore and main topsails
12 close reefed the main topsail edging by
the wind over the starboard tucks blowing
A gale so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday May the 15th this
commenced with A gale of wind from the
E by E are in the starboard tucks 4 Am
moderating middell thick fog and calm latter
light breeze from S E set all sail board for
1 whale going quick to E spoke ship under
prise of wallocket so ends this 24 hrs
