

Ship inward Cruising in Codhach May 1857

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 26th

Commenced with a gale of wind from E N E eding S E on the larboard tacks under close reef main topsail middell moderate where ship to N E latter blowing on top A gale 11 pm a gale tuck in the fore sail where ship eding to S E larboard tacks so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 27th this commenced with a gale of wind from E N E we to close reef main topsail eding to S E larboard tacks 4 Am mail crating evy sea running middell where ship eding to N E wind all to S S W strong breeze latter strong breeze and squally 7 pm set dubhell reef topsail spoke ship serotoga of mended for saw severall spouts so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 57° 12' N Long 147° 30' W

Remarks on board Thursday May the 28th this commenced with strong breeze from S S W steering N E under dubhell reef topsails 1 sail in sight 7 tuck in sail and hepped to the wind eding E middell pleasant latter strong breeze from E N E eding by the wind to the N 10 raised 3 whals loerd without suck sess ruged breeing on 1 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday May the 29th this commenced with strong breeze and thick mether 1 Am dubhell reef the topsails 3 close reef the main topsail 4 tuck in the fore sail blowing a gale from E N E ship eding to S E middell blowing heavy latter moderating 7 pm set the foresail 10 set fore and mizen topsails aybhell reef eding to N E saw 3 right whals ruged did not loer blowing thick fog so ends this 24 hrs

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Remarks on board Saturday May the 30th this commenced with strong breeze and fog by spells ship under dubhell reef topsails eding in various tacks wind E loerd for 1 right whale with out suck sess 7 tuck in sail rain storm middell cleared off light breeze and variabells latter the same loerd for 3 right whals hawbole latter 2 sails in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Sunday May the 31th this commenced with light breeze and variabells thick and clouding loerd for a right whale going quick spoke ship emerged of safe harbor 3 whals this seson middell calm latter 10 pm light breeze from N E steering S all sail set severall finbacks in sight 3 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs Lat 58° 03' N Long 145° 56' W

Remarks on board Monday June the 1st this commenced with fresh breeze from N E all sail set eding by the on various tacks loerd for 1 right whale going quick finbacks in sight spoke ship endine reef of new London middell thick fog latter light breeze from N E fine pleasant weather 2 sail in sight large quant etys of finbacks in sight setering various lores so ends this 24 hrs Lat 57° 53' N Long 145° 17' W

Remarks on board Tuesday June the 2nd this commenced with light wind and pleasant mether from N E steering N E all sail set 1 Am loerd for a right whale going quick middell pleasant wind E N E eding on various tacks chasing whals going quick to the N 3 sails in sight land in sight distance 125 miles so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 57° 50' N Long 143° 49' W

Remarks on board Wednesday June 3rd this commenced with light breeze and pleasant mether from E N E all sail set eding in various tacks land in sight 3 sail in sight loerd 2 for whals 7 dubhell reef the topsails middell calm latter strong breeze and fog 18 pm cleared of mpyed in slowing soult waughten so ends this 24 hrs
