Remarks on board Saturday June the 13th this
Commenced with light and calm
saw right whale load for grampas
must have struck tack in to the ship
and heaved in on board muddell calm
later light breeze from E & steering
N & all sail set 4 sail in sight the
men employed in cutting blubber load
for a whale so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 58° 18' N Long 141° 32' W
Remarks on board Sunday June the 14th this
Commenced with light and variables
heaving on various tacks 1st m commenced
hoyling & finished pulled down middell
light winds latter strong breeze eding
to south best spoke ship lammore
& whales, this season large quantities of
finbacks in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Monday June the 15th this
Commenced with strong breeze from
E & N & squally eding to S & E
all sail set 2nd m. load for right
whale, bumpole struck body lost
the line blowing strong ship under
dubbell reef topsails middell thick
and rain latter moderate galle stuck in
fore and misen topsails saw several whales
right did not loer 3 sail in sight so
ends this 24 hrs Lat 58° 14' N Long 141° 57' W

Remarks on board Tuesday June 16th this
Commenced with strong wind from
E eding to south suggest weather under
dubbell reef main topsail 2nd m mod
erating get fore and misen topsails
where ship eding to N & E 1 sail in
sight hoyling middell calm rain latter
fine pleasant weather saw several finbacks
& 3 ships in sight 2 hoyling so
ends this 24 hrs
Lat 57° 37' N Long 141° 55'

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Remarks on board Wednesday June the 17th this
Commenced with light wind from E and pleasant
weather all sail set eding to N & E heard
for whale going quick middell strong breeze
dubbell reef the topsails latter blowing a galle
ove the under close reef main topsail 2 sail in
sight so ends this 24 hrs Lat 58° 11' N Long 141° 00' W

Remarks on board Thursday June the 18th this
Commenced with a gale of wind from E & S
eding to N & E under close reef main topsail
2nd m moderating 4 set dubbell reef topsails
where ship eding to S middell and latter
calm 2 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs
Lat 58° 06' N Long 141° 01' W

Remarks on board Friday June the 19th this
Commenced with light wind from the N
thick clouding weather steering N & E by E & E
all sail set heard for a whale with out
success middell strong breeze and rain dubbell
reef the topsails latter moderate made all
sail load for a whale 5 sail in sight the
men employed in ships duty so ends this 24 hrs
Lat 57° 45' N Long 140° 06' W

Remarks on board Saturday June the 20th this
Commenced with strong breeze from N & E
thick weather heard for a whale 3rd m breezing
on dubbell reef the topsails 5 blowing a
moderate galle stuck in fore and misen topsails
close reef the main squally middell
light wind rain latter fresh breeze and
variables rain 3 sail in sight saw 1 whale
going quick steering various courses so ends this
24 hrs Lat 57° 46' N Long 138° 10' W

Remarks on board Sunday June the 21st this
Commenced with strong breeze from S & W
thick weather saw finback eding on various tacks
spoke harque job and mares of new union 2 whale
this season middell strong breeze and fog by
spells latter the same heard for whales lashing
harbord boat started bow boat started several
sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs
