

Ship inward Cruising on Goddack June 1857

Remarks on board Monday June the 22 this
Commenced with strong breeze from S by E
fog and rain by spells eding on various
tacks leeward for whales middell light
winds and pleasant weather latter the same
leeward for whales land in sight 5 sail in
sight 1 haying so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Tuesday June the 23 this
Commenced with light winds and pleasant
weather from E by S eding on various tacks
chasing whales starboard hove started
And Miss the whale middell pleasant
latter the same eding on various tacks
leeward for whales starboard hove started
and picked the whale 5 ships in sight
one cutting one haying so ends this
24 hrs lat 58° 03' N long 147° 51'

Remarks on board Wednesday June the 24 this
Commenced with light winds and
pleasant weather from the E all sail set
chasing whales middell light winds
latter the same leeward for whales starboard
hove struck 12 tack the whale a long
side bow hove stove by the whale
so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Thursday June the 25 this
Commenced with light winds from
the E eding to N by E 5 sail commenced
cutting the whale middell 10 finished
cutting for the light latter pleasant
6 pm commenced cutting 10 finished
cleared up the decks so ends this 24
hrs

Remarks on board Friday June the 26 this
Commenced with strong breeze from
the E thick and rain eding to S by E
haying middell strong breeze and rain
latter the same where ship heading to
the N under double reef topsails
the men employed in haying so ends
this 24 hrs

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Remarks on board Saturday June the 27 this
Commenced with strong breeze from the E
hiding on various tack thick and rain middell used
latter the same 2 sail in sight 7 pm hake out
in the after hole stowing down oil haying
so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Sunday June the 28 this
Commenced with calm stowing down oil
and haying middell light breeze from the
W by S eding to N by W under double reef topsails
latter fresh breeze thick fog 4 pm broke out
the main aloft and stowing down oil and haying
4 pm finished haying so ends this 24 hrs
lat 58° 09' N long 149° 48' W

Remarks on board Monday June the 29 this
Commenced with strong breeze from W by S
eding to N by W under short sail stowing down
oil in the main aloft 7 Am where ship heading
to the S cruising on middell moderating latter
calm and fog employed in stowing stowing down in
the after hole 12 finished stowing so ends this
24 hrs lat 58° 00' N

Remarks on board Tuesday June the 30 this
Commenced with calm saw several finbacks
6 Am light breeze from S eding by the wind to
W by S all sail set middell steering S by W wind
S by E latter strong breeze thick fog the men
employed in scrubbing line so ends this 24 hrs
lat 57° 19' N long 146° 23' W

Remarks on board Wednesday June the 31 this
Commenced with strong breeze and fog
from E by S steering S by W all sail set 4 Am
wind all S by W tacked ship eding to S by E
light breeze clearing off middell tack had
ship wind all to S by E ship eding S by W
latter strong breeze and variable
starboard tacks A bird eding various
courses employed haying so ends
this 24 hrs lat 57° 09' N long 147° 55' W
