

Ship onward bound to Bristol Bay July 1857

Remarks on board the 2nd July the 2nd this
Commenced with strong breeze and thick
weather wind veering to starboard tacks a hard
edging various ^{lat} by the wind middle
fog and rain so calm the men employed
in various gals ^{at} end for a right whale
so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday July the 3rd this
Commenced with a calm 7 Am light
breeze from S. set sail set edging to
S. E. middle the strong breeze latter tacked
ship edging W. 24 wind alling to the
S so ends this 24 hrs lat 56.51 long 157.30

Remarks on board Saturday the 4th this
Commenced with strong breeze and thick
weather from S. 4 Am raised a
dep. whale & commenced hunting
finished ading pens in in marked barque
pendant breeze. Steer in rain storm wind
alled to S. E. foreing S. E. dubbell reef
main topsail at topsail middle close
reef the main to fore wind all to the N
blowing 4 pm latter wind W. N. W.
10 pm fore sail luffed to the
wind edging N. 4 overgated the tryworks. 11
luffed down foreing a gale
so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board the 5th this
Commenced with a gale of wind from
W. N. W. over sailing to the N. Close
reef again top 1 reef S. 4 Am moderating
to where ship reef S. 4 started the
tryworks let reef up of the main
topsail giving reef strong breeze latter
set dubbell reef topsails wind W. S. W.
edging S. started tack of board the
men impley in luffing out
at so ends lat 24 hrs
54.51 N long 153.24 W

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Remarks on board Monday July the 6th this
Commenced with strong breeze from W. S. W.
thick weather and squally edging to the S under
dubbell reef topsails starboard tacks. luffing
middle strong breeze latter the same 6 pm
finished luffing luffed down 10 where ship
edging W. wind S. W. the men employed in
various gals so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Tuesday July the 7th this
Commenced with strong breeze from S. W.
edging to W. under dubbell reef topsails
breasing up 5 tack in fore and main topsails
Close reef the main topsail & middle S. gale
latter the same wind all S. E. luffing to S. W.
starboard tacks so ends this 24 hrs
lat 54.15 N long 153.08 W

Remarks on board Wednesday July the 8th this
Commenced with a gale of wind from S. E.
edging to S. W. starboard tack under close reef
main topsail fore and main spencers middle
moderating 6 pm set dubbell reef topsails wind
alling to S. W. 9 where ship edging to S. E. squally
so ends this 24 hrs lat 54.36 N long 155.22 W

Remarks on board Thursday July the 9th this
Commenced with strong breeze and squally
weather from S. W. luffing to S. E. under dubbell
reef topsails 3 sails in sight spoke ship ramble
of number 3 wales this seen middle light
winds and calms latter strong breeze and variables
7 pm tacked ship luffing to S. E. & commenced
sto down oil in the after hole 3 sail in
sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday July the 10th this
Commenced with strong breeze and variables
luffing on the starboard tack to the S. E. starting
down oil 5 Am finished tacked ship luffing
to W. by 11 all sail set middle strong breeze
thick fog and rain steering S. W. wind E
under dubbell reef topsails latter the
same the men employed in various gals
so ends this 24 hrs
