

Ship. onward Cruising in Bristol Bay July 1857

Remarks on board Monday July the 20th this

Commenced with a calm and thick cloudy weather middle light breeze from ESE all sail set thick fog by spells latter the same steering N by E & the men employed in various jobs so ends this 24 hrs. lat 56° 06' N long 164° 17' W

Remarks on board Tuesday July the 21st this

Commenced with light breeze from ESE all sail set steering N by E thick cloudy weather middle light breeze and fog latter strong breeze fog by spells spoke ship Kemell of Sike harbor & walls this season saw large quantities humpbacks and finbacks so ends this 24 hrs.

Remarks on board Friday July the 22nd this

Commenced with strong breeze from E by S heading by the wind to N by E all sail set spoke ship Jason of New Bedford 4 miles & sail in sight middle strong breeze tack in fore and misen topsails heading to the S latter subhell reef topsails thick fog and rain so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Saturday July 23rd this

Commenced with light breeze and thick fog from SE 2 AM cleared off set all sail heading in various tacks

4 AM heard for whales with out such press middle strong breeze subhell the topsails latter the same saw humpbacks and finbacks the men employed in ships duty so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday July the 24th this

Commenced with strong breeze from the S ship under dubhell reef topsails heading W by N 4 AM tack in fore and misen topsails & close reef the main top sail blowing at gale middle moderated to strong breeze and rain latter the same 7 AM ship heading to E by N under dubhell reef topsails so ends this 24 hrs

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Remarks on board Saturday July the 25th this

Commenced with a strong breeze from SE and thick rain storm ship under dubhell reef topsails heading to E by N 7 AM tack in fore and misen topsails where ship heading to S by E 1 sail in sight middle strong breeze and rain 7 tack in sail latter light breeze and fog set all sail heading in various tacks so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Sunday July the 26th this

Commenced with light breeze from SE thick weather heading in various tacks saw several humpbacks and finbacks 2 sail in sight middle fog and rain latter thick fog and rain by spells heard for humpbacks 11 AM how late struck plenty in sight 2 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Monday July 27th this

Commenced with fog and rain & clear by spells saw a whale fast to a humpback killed and sunk the whale took the line to the ship partly the line lost the whale wind all to the ship steering various courses middle the same latter heading to W wind N by W spoke ship briganses of New Bedford 2 whales 5 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs

lat 57° 05' N long 164° 32' W

Remarks on board Tuesday July the 28th this

Commenced with light breeze from N by W heading to W by S 4 AM all sail set 1 AM thick fog 4 AM steered ESE 7 strong breeze dubhell reef the topsails cleared off saw humpbacks 1 sail middle layed a back 11 strong breeze tack in fore and misen topsails thick fog latter moderated made all sail steering in various courses the men employed in various jobs so ends this 24 hrs
