

Ship inward Cruising in Bristol Bay July 1857

Remarks on board Wednesday July the 29th this

Commenced with strong breeze from the NW by spells steering various courses spoke ship-murrell & wales middell strong breeze latter fog by spells steering NW by 4 PM saw 1 right whale aboard without success 5 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Thursday July the 30th this

Commenced with a strong breeze from S by steering various courses located for a whale going quick but thick fog middell the same being back latter clear by spells heard for whales without success 3 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday 31st this
lat 57° 50' N long 162° 40' W

Commenced with light winds and present weather S by full sail set boats chasing whales spoke ship galed 4 whales preserved from ship galed 5 lbs of beef middell fog latter thick weather blowing a moderate gale saw several whales 3 sail in sight heading in various tack so ends this 24

Remarks on board Saturday August the 1st this

Commenced with a moderate gale from the NW by under dubbell reef topsails heading in various tacks 6 AM moderating thick cloudy weather middell fog latter the same heading in various tack under dubbell reef topsails so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Sunday August the 2nd this

Commenced with strong breeze and thick fog from NW by heading in various tacks thick in sail middell fog latter the same heading in various tack so ends this 24 hrs

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Remarks on board Monday August the 3rd this

Commenced with strong breeze from NW by thick fog heading to NW spoke barque hellick 3 wales 6 AM cleared off pleasant weather middell strong breeze thick fog latter the same heading in various tacks the men employed in ship duty so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Tuesday August the 4th this

Commenced with strong breeze from NW by thick fog under single reef topsails working to the NW by under ship heading to the S middell breezing on latter a moderate gale thick in fore and main topsails 10 PM where ship heading to NW by wind S by thick fog 1 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Wednesday August the 5th this

Commenced with a moderate gale of wind from S by heading to NW by under dubbell reef main topsail and foresail 6 AM cleared off raised a dead whale back in a long side and plucked in breezing on close reef the main topsail heading to S middell a gale latter moderate & PM commenced cutting rigging wind shifted to NW by spoke barque type 3 wales so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Thursday August the 6th this

Commenced with a moderate gale from NW by fog by spells cutting a wale to leeward 3 AM finished cutting set dubbell reef topsails heading to NW by moderating spoke ship alighted returned the line and was commenced hauling middell light breeze where ship heading to S by latter strong breeze under single reef topsails 9 PM cutled down waughter in the hulk 5 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs lat 56° 45' N long 164° 02' W

Remarks on board Friday August 7th this

Commenced with strong breeze from NW by spells ship under dubbell reef topsails whale in the hulk her name 8 PM commenced to haul latter 6 PM by spells saw several hump back the men employed in various gales so ends this 24 hrs lat 57° 42' N long 164° 04'
