

Ship inward Cruising in Bristol Bay September 1857

Remarks on board Tuesday September the 8 this

Commenced with light winds and variable winds steering S W by W thick fog rain storm beginning middell strong breeze rain latter storm breeze from S W S W steering E 11 pm tack in fore and missen topsail 2 sail in sight the men employed in hauling oil so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 57°34' N Long 165° 44' W

Remarks on board Wednesday September the 9 this

Commenced with strong breeze from S S W heading by the wind to S E ship under duhhell reef main topsail and fore sail hauling middell strong breeze latter the same 6 sail in sight saw Humphreys the men employed in hauling so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 57°16' N Long 163°54' W

Remarks on board Thursday September the 10 this
Commenced with strong breeze from the S heading to E S under short sail hauling spoke ship Chapells barell middell strong breeze and rain latter the same 6 sail in sight the men employed in hauling so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 57°22' N Long 161°21' W

Remarks on board Friday September the 11 this
Commenced with strong breeze from S E thick weather rain steering various courses 2 Am finished hauling stake having prudent middell light breeze being a back latter steering N W fresh breeze 1 sail in sight 7 pm
Commenced to stow down oil in the fore hold so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Saturday September the 12 this
Commenced with strong breeze from S S W steering N W under singell reef topsails breezing on rain 2 Am land in sight to E N E luffed to the wind heading S W S W tack in fore and missen topsails breezing on 4 Am finished stowing oil middell strong breeze latter the same employed in scraping bar so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 58°58' N Long 165°31' W

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Remarks on board Sunday September the 13 this

Commenced with strong breeze from S S W heading by the wind to W by S under duhhell reef topsails spoke ship rain from at my bedford middell strong breeze latter wind abated to E ship heading to the S breezing on rain 1 sail in sight so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Monday September the 14 this

Commenced with strong breeze of wind from the E thick rainey weather ship heading to south by W 2 Am tack in fore and missen topsails 3 Close reefed the main topsail 4 furlled the fore sail following a gale are in breezing on middell 11 Am blowing every latter moderating 10 Calm every small fog rain so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Tuesday September the 15 this

Commenced with a calm fog every small 5 Am light breeze from N W by W fog by spells ship under duhhell reef topsails 7 tack in fore and missen topsails middell breezing on 10 tack in the foresail Close reefed the main topsail wind S W by S blowing a gale ship are in on far head tack latter blowing every so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 58°27' N Long 168°15' W

Remarks on board Wednesday September the 16 this

Commenced with a gale of wind from N W heading on the far head tack to S W 1 Am moderating where ship heading to S E set close reefed topsails middell strong breeze rain latter a gale of wind from E N E steering W S W ship under close reef main topsail and fore sail 11 pm luffed to the wind being to N furlled the fore sail so ends this 24 hrs

Lat 58°10' N Long 169°27' W

Remarks on board Thursday September the 17 this

Commenced with a gale of wind from E N E were the heading to S W 1 Am moderating set close reefed topsails steered S W 2 Am set duhhell reefed topsails strong breeze middell luffed to the wind heading to N W Close reefed the main topsail latter wind N W steered S S W strong breeze Close reefed topsails spoke barque newbery port bound out so ends this 24 hrs
