

Ship inward bound out of Bristol bay september 1857

Remarks on board Friday September the 18 this

Commenced with strong breeze from WNW
squally rain ship under double reef topsails
steering S by W middle strong breeze squally
latter a moderate gale clear weather steering
SSE under single reef topsails and bores
so ends this 24 hrs lat 54°33' N long 172°20' W

Remarks on board Saturday September the 19 this

Commenced with a moderate gale of wind
from WNW steering SSE under single reef
topsails 1 sail in sight 7 Am close reef the
main topsail are in heading to S W middle
moderate gale latter the same 9 pm steered SSE
close reef topsails 3 sail in sight so ends
this 24 hrs lat 52°57' N long 152°02' W

Remarks on board Sunday September the 20 this

Commenced with a moderate gale of wind
from NW steering SSE under double reef
topsails 1 sail in sight 12 land in sight distance
30 miles 4 Am past thru the straits set
main topsails sail moderating 7 Am long
distance 25 miles having NW middle
strong breeze latter light wind and calm
so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Monday September the 21 this

Commenced with a calm 2 Am light
breeze from SE 4 Am strong breeze 6 double
reef the topsails breezing up wind gradually
coming to the E rain 8 Am close reef the main
topsail furled the fore sail middle a
gale latter moderated wind called the
NW a moderate gale ship under double reef
topsails so ends this 24 hrs
lat 44°46' N long 169°27' W

Remarks on board Tuesday the September the 22 this

Commenced with a moderate gale from
the W steering ESE under double reef
topsails clear weather middle SSE by E by S
latter the same ship under single reef
topsails so ends this 24 hrs
lat 47°55' N long 164°05'

Ship inward bound to the sun with is september the 1857

Remarks on board Wednesday September the 23 this

Commenced with a moderate gale of wind from WNW
steering south E by E under double reef topsails
clear weather middle the same latter moderated steered
SSE by S all sail set bent a new mainsail reed up the
hold in the men employed in various gals so ends this
24 hrs lat 44°57' N long 161°58' W

Remarks on board Thursday September the 24 this

Commenced with moderate wind from WNW
steering SSE by S all sail set 4 Am set topmast stunsail
cloudy weather middle pleasant weather later light
winds E heading by the wind to S thick weather rain
so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday September the 25 this

Commenced with light wind and variable rain
3 Am wind all to WNW 4 double reef the
topsails 5 furled the mainsail breezing in clear
weather middle squally latter strong breeze and
squally close reef the topsails a gale the men
employed in various gals so ends this 24 hrs
lat 40°42' N long 159°12' W

Remarks on board Saturday September the 26 this

Commenced with a gale of wind from S W and
heavy squalls ship steering SE by E 1 Am
furled the foresail are in under close reef
mainsail 3 Am moderated set double reef
topsails wind all to the W thick and
runny middle pleasant latter strong breeze and
squally the men employed in various gals
so ends this 24 hrs
lat 38°48' N long 158°13' W

Remarks on board Sunday September the 27 this

Commenced with strong breeze and squally
weather from WNW steering SSE 1 Am tack
in light sails 3 double reef the topsails in place
in breaking out between decks middle moderate
gale ship under close reef topsails latter fresh
breeze set all sail set stunsails sent up
the main yard and sail the men em-
ployed in various gals so ends this 24 hrs
lat 35°20' N long 157°17' W
