Remarks on board Monday september the 28 this

Commenced with light wind and pleasant weather from N^W steering S by E all sail set middell
balm latter light breeze from S^W & clear weather
ship heading to S & all sail set employed in
cleansing out between decks and various so ends
this 24 hrs lat 34° 06' N long 156° 30' W

Remarks on board Tuesday september the 29 this

Commenced with a fresh breeze from S by W
pleasant weather ship heading to S & 20 m. thick in
fore and mizen topsails flying with sail in
sight in the weather been middle present
latter the same the men employed in putting
rigen and various gobs so ends this 24 hrs

lat 32° 24' N long 154° 39' W

Remarks on board Wednesday september the 30 this

Commenced with light wind from S by W
pleasant weather ship heading to S & all sail set
on the starboard tacks pinfall wind all to
the W light breeze latter the same set
stunsails the men employed in various gobs
so ends this 24 hrs

lat 31° 15' N long 153° 43' W

Remarks on board Thursday october the 1 this

Commenced with light winds and variable
pleasant all sail set sent up topgallens
employed in putting rigen middle balm
latter light wind and balm employed
in washing ship in side so ends this
24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday october the 2 this

Commenced with wind variable
with balm employed in washing ship
in side 4 pm finished middle balm latter
light breeze from N^W steering S by E
all sail set employed in washing ship
out side so ends this 24 hrs

lat 31° 05' N long 152° 43' W

Ship inward bound to make october 1 1857

Remarks on board Saturday october the 3 this

Commenced with light wind and variable steering
S by E all sail set washing ship out side 2 pm finished
middle light breeze from N^W latter the same saw
black fish the men employed in various gobs
so ends this 24 hrs

lat 29° 15' N

Remarks on board Sunday october the 4 this

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the N^W light
squalls stunsails set steering S by E middle strong
breeze latter squalls clearing S by W the men
employed in ships duty so ends this 24 hrs

lat 25° 52' N

Remarks on board Monday october the 5 this

Commenced with a strong breeze and squalls
weather from N^W steering S by W all sail set
2 sail in sight heading to the S middle strong
breeze latter the same 3 sail in sight the men employe
in various gobs so ends this 24 hrs

lat 22° 35' N long 155° 57' W

Remarks on board Tuesday october the 6 this

Commenced with strong breeze from the E steering
S by E all sail set middle duck in light sails
2 pm lay with the main yard & back latter
heavy squalls rain blowing Lake or wind 6 pm
eye in sight distance 40 miles from 3 pm until 2 pm
sailed out of the way the men employed in
ships duty so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Wednesday october the 7 this

Commenced with a gale of wind from E & N
heavy squalls thick weather and rain over the
under close reef main fore sail and fore sail
heading to the S by W middle the same latter strong from
N^W 5 pm set all sail and steered in for the land
made distance 20 miles 11 land 5 miles so ends this
24 hrs
