Remarks on board Thursday October the 8th this
Commenced with strong trades running
down the passage of noon 5 AM came to
anchor at noon 1 mile off shore & ships to anchor
middle calm latter light breeze from
SW sent a raft of casks on shore the men
employed in packing ship and fitting
rigs so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Friday Oct 9th this
Commenced with light breeze from SW
ship at anchor middle pleasant latter
the same got off a raft of waughters stowed
in down so ends this 24 hrs in port

Remarks on board Saturday October the 10th this
Commenced with pleasant weather sent
on shore a raft of casks middle pleasant
latter the same packing the main yard got
off a raft of waughters stowed in down so
ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Sunday October the 11th this
Commenced with pleasant weather sent
a raft of casks on shore sent 8 men on
liberty middle rain latter the same got
off a raft of waughters so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Monday October the 12th this
Commenced with light wind and rain
sailing down waughters rescued on board
32 lbs of beef and 16 boxes of bread latter
pleasant so ends this 24 hrs

Remarks on board Tuesday October the 13th this
Commenced with pleasant weather
striking a very wet latter lused sails drying
home and bunsling here so ends this 24 hrs

the decks for sea so ends
