First part moderate gale from the NW steering NW per compass middle and latter part light breeze from the SW steering NW with all sail set employed in various duties wet hold and side Bone 001 nothing in sight all hands well so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Sunday February 8th

First part light breeze from the SW steering NW per compass all sail set middle and latter part wind much the same steering NW with all sail set so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Monday February 9th

First part fine pleasant weather and light breeze from the NW steering NW per compass with all sail set at 8 PM took in sail and luffed to the wind middle part fine at 4 PM Sun^d the land the Island of Natchez bearing ENE per compass latter part being off and on one boat on shore nothing in sight so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 9th 1852

First part fine pleasant weather and gentle breeze from the South being off and on at Monkey 5 PM the boat came on board and started off with middle and latter part strong breeze from the SSE and heavy sea running steering NW per compass cleared away back in sight employed repairing the fore top sail so ends

Remarks on Board February Wednesday 10th

First part fresh gale from the SSE and pleasant weather steering NW per compass at 3 PM spoke ship Ciozimbo of New Bedford under and latter part fresh gale and clear weather being to with fore sail and double reef main the boat saw a ship steering to the South and Eastward

Watch employed in various duties so ends 24 hours

Remarks on Board Thursday February 11th

First part moderate gale from the SSE and clear weather and heavy sea running luffing to under small sail saw a ship steering ENE middle and latter part wind and weather much the same finished repairing the fore top sail and bent it nothing in sight so ends these 24 hours
