Remarks on Board Friday February 12<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1858

First part fresh gales from the SSE clear  
weather steering by the compass. With double reefed  
the sails middle and latter part fine and weather  
the same at 11 AM saw the land rising & fell  
all hand well so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday February 13<sup>th</sup>  
First part fine pleasant weather and light breeze  
from the North at 4 PM came to anchor in the  
harbor of Valparaiso in 4 fath water

Remarks on Board Sunday February 14<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours fresh breeze from the North  
and overcast weather the anchor at Valparaiso  
was employed in various duties so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Monday February 15<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours rainy overcast weather and  
fresh breeze from the North took on board 9 AM  
steamed out on foot one watch on liberty

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 16<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and light  
breeze Southward employed drying barrels and other  
ship duties so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Wednesday February 17<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather employed  
painting ship one watch on liberty so ends

Remarks on Board Thursday February 18<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1858

These 24 hours fine pleasant weather and light breeze from the  
SW. employed in ship duty one watch on liberty

Remarks on Board Friday February 19<sup>th</sup>

First part fine pleasant weather latter part fresh breeze  
from North and rainy overcast weather employed in various  
duties so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday February 20<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours fresh gale from the North  
and rainy weather so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Sunday February 21<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours rainy overcast weather one watch  
on liberty and the blacksmith in rigging so ends

Remarks on Board Monday February 22<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather employed  
looking after the Barke Moring Star  
George Stanton Boat Steerer started the ship so ends

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 23<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather employed stow-  
ing down oil and other ship duties so ends
