

Remarks on Board Sunday March 7th A.D. 1854

First part variable winds and cloudy weather
at 6 P.M. the wind hauled from SSW to SSE
cast tacke ^{Ship} heading S by W on harbor tacke
per compass middle part variable winds and
latter part wind from the SSW and cloudy
weather at 12 A.M. the wind hauled to the SE
tacked ship so ends this 24 hours
Lat 38.16 S

Remarks on Board Monday March 8th

First part fresh breeze from the SE and
squaly weather ship by the wind on the
harbor tack middle and latter part strong
variable wind from SSW to SE ship by the
wind under double reefed top sails
watch employed repairing blackstraps
mating in sight so ends these 24 hours
Lat 38.08 S Long 85.06 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 9th

First part fresh breeze from the SE
and dark cloudy weather ship by the wind
on the Starboard tack under single
reef top sails a ship in sight to the
leeward on the westward tack middle and
latter part light breeze from the Southward
and variable weather a ship in sight to
the leeward so ends these 24 hours no Ob

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 10th

First part light variable wind and dark
cloudy weather at 1 P.M. a fresh breeze from
the S.W. by the middle part fresh gale from
the West and squaly weather steering
S.E. per compass at 1 P.M. took in the
top galest sails and double reefed the
top sails latter part light breeze from
the Southward and heavy flea running
so ends
Lat 41.06 S Long 84.42 W

Remarks on Board Thursday March 11th

First part light breeze from the Southward and
overcast weather and heavy sea running ship
by the wind on the Starboard tack at 4 P.M. tacked
Ship middle part light and variable wind at 2 P.M.
tacked ship heading S.E. by E per compass on the
Starboard tack by the wind latter part wind and
weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Friday March 12th

First part part fresh breeze from the West
and dark cloudy weather steering SSE per
compass middle part wind and weather much the
same latter part light variable wind and
calm so ends these 24 hours
Lat 44.31 S
Long 84.01 W

Remarks on Board Saturday March 13th

This day commenced with a fine breeze from
the North and overcast weather steering SSE
per compass with all set middle and latter part
rainy overcast weather steering SSE with all
sail set employed in this duty so ends
these 24 hours no Ob

Remarks on Board Sunday March 14th

First part fresh breeze from the N.W. and rainy
overcast weather steering SSE per compass with
all sail set employed mending hole and other
ship duty middle part squally rainy weather took in
sail to double reefed top sails latter part fine
clear weather wind hauled to the North steering
N.E. with all sail set so ends these 24 hours
Lat 48.02 S
Long 82.10 W

Remarks on Board Monday March 15th

First part rainy overcast weather fresh breeze from the
North steering SSE per compass all sail set middle middle and
latter part variable wind and heavy rain steering
S.E. by S so ends these 24 hours
Lat 51.01 S
