

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 24th 1858

This day commenced with fresh gale from the SSW and heavy sea running steering N by E per compass middle and latter part wind from the same steering N by E so ends these 24 hours Lat 33.58 S Long 88.33 W

Remarks on Board Thursday March 25th

First part fine fresh breeze from the West and pleasant weather steering N by E per compass middle part wind and weather the same latter part rain (ered) weather and heavy sea running wind from the SSW ship heading to the North by the wind so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Friday March 26th

This day commenced with rain, foggy weather and heavy sea running and fresh breeze from the WSW ship by the heading to the Northward middle and latter part wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday March 27th

First part rain, foggy weather and light breeze from the N by W ship heading to the Northward by the wind middle part calm latter part fresh gale from the SSW steering N by W per compass so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Sunday March 28th

First part fresh gale from SSW and a heavy sea running preceding before the gale at 11 PM luffe to and took in the fore sail and closed reefed the main top sail at 8 AM kept off N by E per compass so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Monday March 29th 1858

First part fresh gale from SSW and overcast weather steering North per compass at 11 AM the wind headed to the West blowing a fresh gale and a large sea running latter part the same wind under storm sails on the larboard tack heading up N by W off N by E so ends

Lat 45.29 S

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 30th

First part blowing till 12 noon and middle and latter part more moderate the wind from the SSW steering N by W per compass so ends these 24 hours

Lat 44.32 S Long 88.12 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 31th

First part light variable wind and overcast weather heavy sea running steering N by W per compass middle and latter part fresh breeze from the N by E and foggy weather ship by the wind on the Starboard tack so ends these 24 hours

Lat 43.28 S

Remarks on Board Thursday April 1st 1858

This day commenced with a moderate gale from the N by E and overcast weather ship by the wind on the Starboard tack middle part wind and weather much the same latter part light breeze from the SSW and variable weather steering N by E per compass so ends these 24 hours

Lat 42.25 S Long 80.07 W

Remarks on Board Friday April 2nd

First part light breeze from the SSW and variable weather steering N by E per compass middle part wind and weather much the same latter part variable wind and fine pleasant weather ship by the wind on the Starboard tack with all sail set watch employed repairing a mixer foremast sail so ends these 24 hours
