

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 14th 1858

First part moderate gale from the N^WE and squally weather ship heading to the Eastward under double reefed top sails middle part wind and weather much the same latter part fresh gale from the N^W and dark cloudy weather at 6 AM took in the gill and main sails and closed reefed the main top sail steering E^{SE} per compass 32 miles at 4 PM

Remarks on Board Thursday April 15th

First part fresh gale from the N^W and dark cloudy weather steering E^{SE} per compass middle and latter part more moderate at 4 AM the wind hauled to the S^W at 6 AM made all sail saw a ship to the Northward steering to the Eastward so ends these 24 hours Lat 32.01 S Long 32.56 W

Remarks on Board Friday April 16th

First part fine pleasant weather and light breeze from the West steering N^WE per compass all sail set middle and latter part wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours Lat 31.05 S

Remarks on Board Saturday April 17th

This day commenced with light variable winds and rainy overcast weather steering N^WE per compass all hands employed rattring down the rigging middle and latter part wind and weather much the same so ends these 24 hours Lat 30.45 S

Remarks on Board Sunday April 18th

First part light variable winds and rain middle and latter part fine breeze from the SE and pleasant weather steering N^WE per compass with all sail set so ends 24 hours Lat 29.05 S

Long 31.23 W

Remarks on Board Monday April 19th 1858

First part fine pleasant weather and fresh breeze from the SE steering N^WE per compass with all sail set middle and latter part wind and weather much the same saw a ship heading to the Eastward so ends these 24 hours Lat 28.20 S

Long 30.54 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 20th

First part fresh breeze from the South and variable weather steering N^WE per compass all sail set at 4 PM sent up the main royal yard saw a ship steering East middle and latter part fine pleasant weather steering N^WE all hands employed sitting up rigging so ends these 24 hours Lat 27.34 S Long 30.01 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 21th

First part fine pleasant weather and fresh breeze from the South steering N^WE per compass all sail set at 4 PM saw the land the Island of Trinidad bearing N^W middle and latter part wind and weather much the same steering N^W so ends these 24 hours Lat 18.57 S

Long 30.30 W

Remarks on Board Thursday April 22th

This day commenced with fresh SE trade winds and fine pleasant weather steering North per compass all sail set middle and latter part wind and weather the same so ends these 24 hours Lat 15.25 S

Long 30.39 W

Remarks on Board Friday April 23th

First part fine pleasant weather and strong SE trade winds steering N^WE per compass middle and latter part light winds and rain squalls from the Eastward steering N^W with all sail set so ends these 24 hours Lat 12.15 S

Long 31.25 W
