First part fine pleasant weather and moderate breeze from the Eastward steering North per compass at 7 PM spoke the Ship William Tell from Boston bound to Batavia middle and latter part light SE trad wind steering N by E at 11 AM saw a ship to the westward second these 24 hours
Lat 10.28 S Long 32.13 W

Remarks on Board Sunday April 25th

First part fine pleasant weather and light SE trad winds steering N by W per compass all sail set all hands employed in various duties middle and latter part wind and weather much the same latter part steering N by W per compass so ends this day
Lat 08.30 S Long 33.00 W

Remarks on Board April 26 Monday

First part fine pleasant weather and light SE trad winds steering N by W per compass at 9 PM spoke the Barque Mary Brown of Boston from northwards bound to Boston middle and latter part light breeze from the Southward steering North so ends this day
Lat 06.19 S Long 34.26 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 27

First part light breeze from the South and fine pleasant weather steering North per compass all sail set middle and latter part variable winds and squally weather so ends these 24 hours No obs
