First part fine pleasant weather
and moderate breeze from the
NE heading N^W by W per compass
middle and latter part wind and
weather much the same so ends

Lat 04 15 N Long 41. 39

Remarks on Board Monday ~~April~~ 3rd

First part fine pleasant weather
and light breeze from the NE
steering N^W per compass a ship
in sight ahead middle and latter part
strong NE head wind steering N^W
at 2 AM passed a large ship at 6 AM spoke
Ship Tamerlane of New Bedford

Lat 06 11 N
Long 43 13 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 4th
First part fine pleasant weather and
strong NE head wind steering
N^W per compass a ship in sight

a head steering the same way middle
and latter part wind and weather much
the same at 2 AM spoke the ship
Sea Fox and took a passage out
of here so ends these 24 hours

Lat 08 15 N Long 44

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 5th
First part fine pleasant weather
and strong NE head wind
steering N^W by W per compass
middle and latter part wind and weather
much the same so ends these 24 hours

Lat 10 45 N Long 48. 27 W

Remarks on Board Thursday May 6th
Fine pleasant weather and moderate
NE head wind steering N^W by W
per compass middle and latter part
the same so ends Lat 13. 20 N Long 57 48 W
