

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 19 1858

First part fine pleasant weather
and light breeze from the S.W. Ship
by the wind on the starboard tack
at 4 PM the wind hauled to the
North West Wave Ship leading
W by W per compass on the
starboard tack middle and latter
part light variable winds and calm
steering N.W. by W So ends 24 hours
Lat 30.14 N Long 64.13 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 19th

First part fine pleasant weather and
light breeze from the South West
steering N.W. by W per compass
middle and latter part fine breeze
from the S.W. steering N.W. by W
So ends these 24 hours

Lat 30 43 N Long 65 44 W

Remarks on Board Thursday May 20th 1858

First part fine pleasant weather
and moderate breeze from the S.W.
steering N.W. by W per compass
middle part wind and weather much
the same latter part variable
winds and rainy weather so ends
24 obs

Remarks on Board Friday May 21st

First part pleasant weather and
moderate breeze from the S.W.
steering N.W. by W per compass
middle and latter part wind
and weather much the same
steering N.W. by W at 9 AM
saw a Spinnaker Whale close
shore board and the mast of
boat struck and lowered
the whale so ends these 24 hours
Lat 30 39 N Long 66 14 W
