This day commences with dark
cloudy weather and fresh breeze
from the ESE steering per
compass N by W with all sail
set employed heaving the topworks
overboard &c middle and latter part
fresh breeze from the ESE steering
N by W rainy overcast weather
to end this 24 hours

Lat 40.00 N

Remarks on Board Thursday May 27th

First part rainy overcast weather
and moderate gale from the East
ward steering North per compass
under double reefed top sails
and fore sail at 4 PM took in
the fore and mizen top sails and
luffed to the wind on the
starboard tack at 4 PM wore ship
middle and latter part wind from
the ESE and high fog ship
lying to under small sail some

Remarks on Board Friday May 28 1858

First part thick fog and rain
and moderate gale from the ESE
Ship lying to under small sail at 4 PM
saw a New York Pilot Boat tall
at that point of sight ESE
middle part wind and weather much the
same latter part more moderate
at 6 PM made sail and stood in
shore so ended this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday May 29

First part pleasant weather and fresh
breeze from the Eastward Ship by
the wind heaving in shore at 3 PM
saw the land the Eastward part
of Long Island middle and latter part
wind and weather the same the ship
working to the windward
so ended this 24 hours
