N.E. with Pleasant weather

Tuesday Oct 22 1867

all these 24 hours light Southerly
wind ship heading S.S.W. most of the
time but winds put the good ship
onward

Lat 19 54 N Long 38 28 W

Wednesday Oct 23 1867

all these 24 hours fresh breeze from S.E.
ship heading by the wind to the southward
at 9 A.M. saw sperm whales lowered
4 boats got 2 small whales got the dark
wain and larboard ^{boats} badly stove at dark
had one of the whales on deck

Lat 18 19 N

Long 37 56 W

Thursday Oct 24

all these 24 hours fresh breeze from E by S and
S.E. first part heading to the Northward
at Daylight cut in the whale and went to the
southward all hands employed cutting up
the whales and fitting boats commenced boiling

Lat 18 21 N Long 37 51 W

Friday Oct 25 1867

all these 24 hours strong trades from E by S ship
heading S by E all sail set most of the
time the watch employed boiling

Lat by obs 16 25 N Long 37 24 W

Saturday Oct 26 1867

all these 24 hours strong trades from
E by S ship heading S.S.E. most of the
time very long at sea running

Lat 14 13 N Long 36 08 W

Sunday Oct 27 1867

all these 24 hours strong N.E. trades from
ship heading S.S.E. all sail set part of the
time saw 2 masted schooners to the wind
ward

Lat 11 21 N Long 34 12 W

5 Weeks since I left my callings at Home
Wife and child

Monday Oct 28 1867

all these 24 hours strong winds from E.S.E.
with heavy squalls of wind and rain
ship heading S.S.E. most of the time

Lat 8 46 N Long 32 30 W

Tuesday Oct 29 1867

all these 24 hours squally bad weather wind
from all points of the compass ship working
to the southward

Lat by acct 7 58 N Long 31 40 W

Wednesday Oct 30 1867

all these 24 hours calm and rainy saw 2
sail to the westward

Lat 7 40 N Long 31 26 W

Thursday Oct 31 1867

all these 24 hours light buff breezes warm mostly
from the Eastward saw black fish

lowered the boats did not get about there
Lat 6 44 N Long 30 54 W
