Remarks Friday November 1 1863

all these 24 hours squally bad weather
wind from the southward southerly
Lat 33° 34' N Long 31° 36' W

Remarks Saturday November 2 1863

all these 24 hours calm and rising
No obs

Sunday Nov 3 1863

all these 24 hours light winds from S & E
with Pleasant weather ship heading S & W
by W most of the time at midday lowered for
black fish No luck If this wind holds
I think I shall be bothered to get by the Brazils
but I must trust to Providence

Lat 33° 25' N

Long 33° 05' W

Monday Nov 3 1863

first and much part of these 24 hours
light baffling winds with rain later part
fresh breeze from S & E ship heading
S & W by the Wind all sail set
at very dark look for getting by the Brazils
the ship makes more West than she does
South

Lat 32° 30' N Long 33° 30' W

Tuesday Nov 5 1863

all these 24 hours fresh S & E trades with pleasant
weather ship heading S & W by the wind
all sail set saw a Bone shark

Lat 33° 20' miles South

Long 34° 36' W

before the wind will
haul more to the Eastward 2 Points more
would save tacking But must in Providence
So good flight

Wednesday Nov 6 1863

all these 24 hours fine S & E trades ship
heading S by W by the wind all sail set
Lat 32° 56' S

Long 34° 46' W

I wish the wind would haul about East
for 2 Days till I get by Cape Augustine

Thursday Nov 7 1863 all these 24 hours fine S & E
trades ship by the Wind heading to the Southward
by the Wind the boat coast of Brazil in
sight to the Westward distant 20 miles
Lat 32° 26' S Long 34° 40' W

Remarks Friday Nov 8 1863

all these 24 hours light Easterly Wind
Ship heading at long the Land to the Southward
at 4 P.M. passed Cape Augustine
Lat 34° 36' Long 34° 41'

Saturday November 9 1863

all these 24 hours fresh S & E trades with pleas-
ant weather had a heavy swell from the Southward
Ship steering S by E all sail set saw several
sail Every thing looks prosperous for a
good Passage much brighter than it did on
Week Ago

Lat 30° 33' S

Long 34° 54' W

Sunday November 10

all these 24 hours light Easterly Wind and
Pleasant weather Ship steering S by W
all sail set 2 sail in sight

Lat 13° 10' S

Long 35° 10' W
