N^W & with pleasant weather course
S by W all sail set Put out a new
Boat for the mate. Repaired fly gable

Tuesday Nov 12 1864

first part fresh breeze from North steering S by E
later part wind hauled to the southward with
rain ship by the wind on different tacks
under short sail

the obs Lat by acct 14 10 S

Long 35.40 W

Wednesday Nov 13 1864

all these 24 hours fresh breeze from South
with Pleasant weather ship heading W S W
most of the time sent down main royal
yard to put the rigging crossed at 8 o'clock

Lat 14 35 S Long 37 15 W

Thursday Nov 14 1864

all these 24 hours light S S E W pleasant
Weather ship heading S W and S S W
lowerd sail in sight Bent fore stay sail

18 52 S Long 38 16 W

Friday Nov 15 1864

most of these 24 hours fresh
breeze from East to N^W ship steering S S W
Lat 20 30 S and S W by S all sail set Late lowerd sail
Long 38 33 W passed 2 at going the same as I was

Saturday

Nov 16 first part strong N^W wind steering
S W by S later part wind from N to S S E
stowed down 10 fathoms of sperm oil
Lat above long state

Sunday 17 1864 all these 24 hours fresh N^W wind
and some rain saw nothing ship steering
S W all sail set

Lat 23 43 S Long 42 34 W

Monday Nov 18

all these 24 hours fine breeze from the East
with pleasant weather course S W the water

Lat 35 33 employed setting up topsmast backstays
Long 44 32 had a man fall over board he got on
board double quick saw hump backs

Tuesday Nov 19 1864

Lat 38 33 S all these 24 hours light Easterly Wind and pleasant
Long 46 54 W Weather saw glass rises

Wednesday Nov 20 1864

all these 24 hours light Easterly
Wind with pleasant weather steering
S W all blowing sail set Lat 28 30 Long 47 20

Thursday Nov 21 all these 24 hours strong breeze
from N^W & ship steering S W saw
3 sails Lat 31 33 S Long 49 30 W

Friday Nov 22 all these 24 hours fresh breeze from
N^W & ship steering S S W saw one ^{sail} ~~boat~~
Lat 34 30 S Long 51 19 W

Wednesday November 27 1864

all these 24 hours fresh breeze from West
with pleasant weather ship heading S S W
most of the time

Lat 42 01 S

Long 59 23 W
