Later part fine breeze from West with Pleasant Weather Ship running along the IC to the NE In company with ship Reindeer

Friday Aug 14 1868

Strong Wind from W with squalls of snow ship working along the IC to the Westward Reindeer in sight

Lat 40 N

Long 164 30 W

Saturday Aug 15 1868

all these 24 hours fresh West by Wind with snow Later Part Light West on board ship Reindeer in company with ship Jones and Herman

No obs Ship working along the

IC heard of a whale being seen to the Westward dull times

And heard for me

Sabbath Aug 16

Light West Wind ship

Running along the IC to the Eastward

at 5 AM saw a Whale lowered 3 boats

at 10 AM boat struck at 4 feet 10 got the Whale to the ship Later part calm with thick fog

Long 164 30 W

Soundings

21 fathoms water

Tuesday Aug 18 1868

all these 24 hours strong NE Wind with fog squalls at 5 AM saw Whales lowered the boats at 12 AM boat struck

at 4 PM got the Whale to the ship at 9 AM him cut. Dr. Ship of Ice Cape

Reindeer in sight all Whaling I think the good gives of all things for this Whaling he is a noble fellow

Thursday Aug 20

fine Weather Employed boiling 3 boats chasing Whales no sail in sight all Whaling

Whales merry day

Lat 40 22 of Ice Cape land distant 15 miles

Sunday Aug 23

all these 24 hours light Easterly Wind and pleasant Weather ship off Ice Cape 4 boats chasing Whales all day no such a large number of ships in sight most of them boiling

Lat 40 30

Tuesday Aug 25 1868

all these 24 hours strong Northerly Wind with clear Weather saw several Whales

Lowered without Luck saw 3 taken

Ship 30 miles North of Ice Cape
