

Dec. 10 1868

Sailed from Honolulu Bound to the W
all Well Wind very light

Friday 11 Light Baffling Winds heading to the
Westwards Employed putting Boats
Lat 21° 04' N
Long 158° 53' W

Saturday Dec 12

first part calm mild and later part fresh
trades with pleasant weather
Steering W by S all sail
Lat 19° 33' N Long 160° 56' W

Thursday Dec 24 1868

all Well but the day had to kill him did not
like to do it but I see no other way to save him
from much misery

Lat 18° 40' N
Long 170° 30' East

Heather A few passages thus far see nothing of the
Whale kind

Friday January 15 1869

Passed through the Bonin Islands In the China Sea
Bound to the Islands of Luzon for Humphreys
A new lead to look for Whales and me at Luzon
time If I don't find them but nothing like trying
with Gods help I shall be successful If not here
I will find Whales Eels &c here
at dusk ship off the N W End of Luzon

Sunday January 31 1869

off the coast of China looking for Devilfish
weather very bad strong winds from the North
with rain most of the time
No obs for several days

Friday February 4 1869

Strong Northerly wind with rain ship
some 40 miles on the coast of China have not
seen the sun for 10 days
Spoke ship Gay Head
Kelly master

Saturday February 13 1869

for the past 10 days all kinds of weather but no
Whales at present state close to Gulf of Islands
bound on to the Japan Sea first for favorable
Wind

Lat 32° 30' N
Long 127° E
