 straits of Corrales In to the Japan Sea
 over 2 months from port No oil luther but
 figures but Luck will come keep trying and trust
 to providence

While passing at Long the coast of Tutuila I saw
 several small villages they looked very pleasant from
 the ship I would like to went on shore but
 not knowing what kind of a reception I should
 receive I dare not put my self in their hands

Wednesday February 17 1869

first part of these 24 hours light westerly
 wind pleasant weather ship off Douglas
 Island 2 boats in shore fishing No Luck
 later part blowing a gale from N. W.
 Lat 37 30 N
 Long 130 15 W

Thursday February 18

all these 24 hours blowing a gale from
 N. W. with thick snow storm
 Ship heading to the N. E. under storm
 sails Lost foretopmast at Tugauia
 No obs

Saturday February 20 1869

for the past 2 days gales from N. and N. W. ship by
 the wind on different tacks No Whales
 Cold weather for the Luffkins

Lat 38 18 N
 Long 133 19 E all well

Sabbath February 28 1869

fine weather with Whales that I could go where they
 are

Lat 37 20 Long 132 30 20 Encls February

Tuesday March 4 1869

all these 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather
 at day light saw white whales and pleasant weather
 chasing all day No Luck had trouble with my
 officers they do not want as I want them to

Lat 41 10 N

Long 137 30 East Asia at 200

About mid day did not have good lights
 Land on sight to the Eastward

Saturday March 6

most of these 24 hours strong southerly wind
 at 3 P. M. saw Whales lowered 3 Boats No Luck
 Lat 40 35
 Long 137 30
