Nothing since leaving Honolulu

Thursday March 11 1869 got under way
from Yokohama In company with Cor Howland
Wind from the Eastward very Light
at dusk Ship outside of the harbor
So commences my Northern Cruise I hope with Gods
Help to get a good seasons work

Friday 16 first fast fresh N.W. wind and heavy
Weather Steady East through Straits of
Matsunag In company Ship Cor Howland
at dusk Wind N.E. Strong
Lat 41° 28' N
Long 144° 09' East all Well

Saturday 21 Blowing a heavy gale from
N.E. with thick snow storm Ship
under storm sails heading to the
S.E. Cor Howland Howland in sight
No jobs

Sunday March 28 1869
most of these 24 hours Light N.E. wind
with pleasant Weather Ship Cor Howland
he had the misfortune to lose a man and Board
in yesterday's Gale
Lat 40 18 N
Long 146 42 East

all well

Monday March 29

all these 24 hours Light easterly Wind
and pleasant Weather Ship heading N.E. by
at most of the time at sunset Went on
Board Ship Cornelius Howland
No obs one man on the Deck List

Tuesday 30 blowing a heavy gale from
E. S.E. with rain and snow Ship heading
N.E. under storm sails at 6 P.M. wind hauled
S.W. Ship steering N.E. Cornelius Howland
close by Side Not Like head gales
but they cant all be fair

Blowing a gale from W.S.W. with snow
and heat Ship steering N.E. In company
