blowing A long the land to the southward
under short sail employed hauling
Saw one Seal

No abo feared blossoms Shoals
at 11 AM

Wednesday Oct 6 1869

Ship off Cape Prince of Wales with
light southerly wind

Henry Baldwin & Seamen
died at 8 AM has been sick for
the past 3 months

Thursday Oct 7 1869

Commenced with fresh N.W. wind and pleasant
weather steering for the Diomedes at 10 AM
Bullies Henry Baldwin & had duty for
at ship master

at Noon close to the diomedes
Saw 3 Seal.

Friday Oct 8 fresh Northerly winds and pleasant
weather steering to the southward at 2 PM
met Saint Lawrence Island bearing N.W. 20
miles so good sight to the
Arctic Ocean for a few months

Dec 1 1869

Left Honolulu at 3 PM Bound to the
coast of California all Steadiness on board
well pleased with them for the first day
So commenced my last years work
on this voyage

Thursday 2

Strong steady S.W. breeze heading
South by the wind under double topped
topsails and courses employed heaving
Boats. Left 22:30 North

think I have a very good

Green
Cabin Boy very Sea

Sick

Friday Dec 3 1869

Strong N.E. breeze ship heading
N by W by the wind all sail

the watch variously employed

Left 24:00 N

Long 157° 38' West

Sabbath day 5th of Dec

blowing at gale from N.E.

but winds for the coast

Left 21:25

Long 158° 15'

Tuesday commenced calm some fresh
puff of a fair wind almost at dusk
from past and gone
