at anchor at Iquica and have been
for the last 16 days waiting for Potatoes to grow
at dusk had 48 bbls on board and started
for Honolulu to get my letters

Saturday April 2

becalmes under Kauri
No Letters to day

Sunday April 3 1870

blowing a gale from N W very
disagreeable I would like good weather
all of the time But that is to go
Must take the Bitter with the sweet
hope I shall go home after this
Season

Long about 160 W

Just had a bust down on the clanes by
a sea

Thursday April 14

Most of the day a gale from N W ship
Heaving to the N E under short sail
dull weather But want last for ever
4 men Liek off duty

Lat 38.40 N

Long 159.40 W

Saw a few seals he is a long ways from
land killed a Pig shall have Rabbit
Peggy for dinner to morrow

Friday April 15 1870

first part strong S W Wind
steering N W by West later Part
Wind changed to N W

Lat 40.20 N

Long 160.10 W

had Peasant Pegg for dinner

Saturday 16 1870

Strong Westerly Wind
Ship Heaving to the Northward
all sail most of the time Killed a beef

Lat 42.08 N Long 160.40 W

Sunday

Friday 17 blowing a gale from
N W ship on short sail but
5 men Liek off duty

Lat 44.02

Long 162.02

Monday 18 Strong S W wind with
hard Steering W S W part of
the time

Tuesday April 19

all these 24 hours fog and Rain some
snow Wind from the westward

Lat about 47.05

Long

161.20 W

Wednesday 20 Westerly winds ship
heaving to the Northward
