all these 24 hours Light westerly wind ship
Working the ice in company with ship Trident
and Eagle passed the day on board the Trident
Lat 60 17 Long 146 08 about 146 East

Friday May 6 1880

Strong N wind and pleasant weather
Started in to the ice found the ice very open
& sail in sight at dark saw 1 whale
Spoke bark Trident Capt Green came on board
Lat 60 38
Long 146 22

Saturday May 7

Light S wind pleasant weather
Ship working to the Northward through heavy ice
Saw several whales No chance to come out
of them Lat 61 06 N
Long 146 23 E
Sail in sight

Sunday May 8

Light S wind and pleasant weather
Ship working through heavy ice to the North
Sail in sight Lat 61 12 N
Saw 2 whales

Monday May 9

Fresh S wind ship in heavy
ice working to the N went on board Bark
Trident & sail in sight
No obs

Tuesday May 10 1880

all these 24 hours Light southerly wind pleasant
weather Saw 1 whale Saw 2 ships whaling
Lat 61 09 N Long

Wednesday May 11

Light S wind with heavy swell from South
Ship pounding heavy bark Trident and Eagle
close by have all we can do to save our keels
at 10 P.M. of yesterday saw several whales
No obs went on board Trident
with Capt Comstock

Thursday May 12

Light southerly wind with foggy ship in
heavy ice heavy swell
No obs
Bark Trident struck a whale faster than

Friday May 13

Frost part moderate fine weather Later part heavy
gale from N at dark heavy swell from the southward
Bad time for skidders
Saw 2 sail to the N & 1 at Belling
Bark Trident and Eagle close by Capt Green
Spent the Afternoon with the saw one whale
Lat 61 22 N No obs Long

Saturday May 14

Heavy gale from E N E with swell from S E ice very
heavy and open ship drifting quick to the Westward
getting and giving some heavy thumps
Bark Trident and Eagle close by
