Sailing off West head as best as I can tell
No obs

Tuesday 21

at 10 AM anchored in Plumes bay under
West head the mostly gone out of the Bay
went on shore gunning No luck

Wednesday June 22

Ship at anchor at Plumes Bay
In company with E. Sagaboth ship John Wells
and Vident the Capt. spent the day on board the
good ship on water had 2 boats off looking
for whale saw nothing

Thursday 23 at Plumes bay thick foggy
2 boats off no whales

Friday June 24

Ship at anchor at Plumes bay boats
off no whales

25 at anchor in Plumes bay

Sunday

26 ship at anchor in Plumes
bay at 8 AM took anchor
worked out bound for Arctic ocean
at 8 PM spoke ship Thalesma
at anchor at 10 PM anchored in Arctic bay

Monday June 27

at 7 AM took anchor at Muscus Bay
at 8 PM anchored at Indian Point
7 other ships

Tuesday June 28

at 10 AM got under way from Indian Point
steering to the North for the Arctic ocean
find the ice very open

Wednesday June 29

Ship off a Lussine Bay spoke ship which
got 300 lbs onions
at 8 PM discovered Islands bearing N &
distant 10 miles

Thursday June 30

fine S.W. wind pleasant weather passed the
Lussine Islands at 3 PM
steering North
Lat 66° 30' N
Long 168° 00' W

Friday July 1 1870

Light baffling winds pleasant weather steering
North for Point Hope
at 3 PM came up to ice packed on to the land
25 miles off shore

Lat 68° 00' N
Long 166° 30' W
