Friday Aug 12 Strong Easterly wind ship
 heading to the Northward through scattering
 ice Saw 3 sails Lett 70.01

Saturday 13 blowing a gale from N.E. with fog
 ship heading East by the wind through scattering
 ice saw several sails " " " "

Lett 69.59 Long by 16.00

at 8 P.M. anchored in 4 fathoms water near
 Point Lays

Sunday 14 Ship at anchor strong gale from
 N.E. at 4 P.M. parted cable went fast anchor
 stood off anchor under storm sail

blowing a gale from N.E. ship under storm
 sails making to the Northward at long the same
 saw several sails Lett 69.33 at

Tuesday Aug 16 Strong N.E. wind ship off by
 Cape employed hauling wall run
 saw one ship hove boats down suppose for whales
 Lett 70.30 Long 164.09

Thursday Aug 17

Strong gale from N.E. ship under
 close reefed topsails employed slowing down wall run
 at 10.00 saw 30.40 gallons saw a number of ships
 saw one heave off and set all sails think something
 was the matter with her

Lett 70.30 Long 164.09

Friday 18 Strong N.E. gale with fog most of the
 time ship making to the windward through
 scattering ice to sea in sight
 No obs

Saturday 19 Wind hauled to to the southward
 with thick fog spoke the Scotch and
 Lett 70.00

Sunday Aug 20 ship starting to the N.E.
 with 20 other ships saw several whales saw the
 boats to look saw several ships backing
 and cutting Lett 70.50

Sabbath 21 ship off Point Franklin with 30 other
 ships plenty of whales whales steady put the last
 24 hours at look saw 12 other ships took whales
 better than I suppose it is full

Monday 22 Strong N.E. gale ship making
 at long the same to the Eastward saw one whale
 at 7 P.M. Point Barrow distant 10 miles heading
 N.E. 20 sail in sight

Tuesday Aug 23

Strong N.E. gale ship close to Point Barrow
 at 2 P.M. saw a whale toward the bow
 worst to out at once
 at 5 P.M. 7 P.M. had him cut in so
 libly thank full for him
