Larboard boat struck at 4 P.M. got him to
the ship at 9 had him cut in at Noble
whale the best I have yet the voyage -
I am truly thankful for him
Spoke Garrison Boat wall came 7 whales

Sunday Sept 11 1870

Barrow saw 10 whales to lower the boats for
saw several taken

Monday Sept 12 strong Easterly gale
ship at Long the Ice Employed stowing
down at the main hatch stowed 4888 galls
finished the main hatch

Tuesday Sept 13
Strong N.E. wind with snow and
Rain ship off Point Barrow saw a
few whales lower the boats N. Luck

Wednesday Sept 14 Light baffling winds
ship off Point Barrow saw a few whales
at 4th mate got a small one saw some ships
take 3

Sept 15 Light S.E. wind with snow at
P.M. saw whales lower the Boats caught
2 small ones at 10 Evening had them cut
Bleke Rill Katamas for missing whales
N. als

Friday Sept 16
Strong westerly wind with snow
ship off Point Barrow saw but few
whales at chance

S.W. ship at Long the Ice Employed stowing
down at Stowed 3842 galls
