Commenced with heavy gale from North
with very heavy sea Middle part moderate
Commenced boiling later part pleasant Employed
stowing out between decks saw a large number
of white whales ^{or} seals In the sight bearing
S W by compass distant 30 miles

Lat 60 30 Long 174 03 west

Wednesday Oct 12 1890

Light Notherly winds and pleasant weather
Steering S S E by compass Employed boiling
shall finish tomorrow if this good weather holds

Lat 59 00 N Long

Thursday Oct 13 fine weather Employed stowing boiling
and coopering and finished boiling at 5 P M saw a ship
to the eastward boiling saw Saint Pauls Island
bearing S S distant 40 miles

Lat 57 41 Long 171 28

bent fore top gallant sail

Friday 14 blowing a heavy gale from N E
Ship by the wind under storm sails

No obs. Stove at last of fresh water

Saturday 15 blowing a heavy gale from N E
ship heading to the N E under storm sails
No obs

Sunday 16 first part a gale from N W
steering South by compass later part all
wind still blew at 4 P M saw the I. lands on the
East side of the 172 pass at last had them bearing
South distant 30 miles but still in sight

Monday Oct 17 1890

all these 24 hours from N W winds with hail
squall course - I E all drawing sail set bound
to Honolulu with 1650 bbls of oil 2500 lbs of
whale bone so good sight to the N E that
seas they have done well for me In fact and
I feel very grateful for my good luck
Lat 50 40 N Long 170 50 west
2 sail in sight

Tuesday Oct 18

Light Notherly winds with heavy swell
which makes the ship roll heavily

course S E by compass saw one sail

Lat 37 54 Long 168 54 west

Wednesday Oct 19 Light Notherly winds with
Pleasant weather all hands Employed stowing
out of between decks stowed 3490 gallons making
52220 gallons for the year a good year for
me found one large top store oil lost
Lat 46 20 Long 167 25 course S E

Thursday Oct 20

A strong N E gale steering
S E under short sail ship making
bad weather commenced sloping bone
Lat 49 50

Friday 21 strong Easterly wind ship
heading to the south

Lat 41 35 Long 165 30

Saturday 22 fresh breeze from the westward
Blessings S E all sail set

Employed sloping bone

Lat 40 40 N Long 164 54 west

Sabbath 23 strong N E winds hauls S E all sail
set Lat 38 27 Long 163 23 west
