Thursday January 3 1871

fine weather Lay at anchor
Wind ship bound Chatham Islands Looking
for Sperm Whales Have seen them once
since I left Honolulu but the Board Leaned
to drive them off without getting anything
Lat 42° 30' S Long 179° 32' West

Friday Jan 6

Fresh breeze from North Ship Steering
East topgallant Sails Set

Saw the Chatham Islands bearing
North distant 30 miles think I shall start
for Cape Horn & so Home be there the first of
May Lat 44° 55' S Long 175° 42'

Sighted the Chatham Islands yesterday

Saturday Jan 7 1871

first part strong wind from N. with fog
& Rain with a heavy sea from North
later part light breeze from S. E. pleasant weather
course E by N all sail set

Lat 45° 55' S Long 171° 25' W

Sunday 8 strong S. E. & S. wind Steering
E. N. E. by compass runs Double Reefed Main top sail
& foresail but cross sea running

Lat 45° 38' S Long 166° 12' West

Monday 9 fresh breeze from S. E. pleasant weather
Steering E. by N all sail at the Main top sail in the
North boat Lat 45° 20' S Long 161° 53' W

Tuesday 10

Light westerly wind & pleasant weather

Lat 45° 30' S

Long 157° 30' W
