Have a fine breeze from N.W. with Rain  
Steering E by N by compass all day. Let  
Spoke bark Helen Snow yesterday 46 days  
from Honolulu left here at 10 AM

Monday January 16 1871

fine breeze from West & N.W. Steering  
East by N. Saw porpoises & help

Lat 48° 32' N Long 129° 10' W

Tuesday January 17 1871

Strong westerly wind all day out last night  
Sawal Lat 48° 33' N Long 123° 25' W

Friday Jan 21 1871

passed the Digges at 12 AM with a fine  
breeze & pleasant weather. Saw several seals  
passed Cape Horn at 6 PM

Thank kind Providence for this safe & pleasant  
Passage thus far. Spoke Bark A. L. L. at 12

Saturday January 28

Light baffling Wind most of  
the time. Ship off Station Land saw several  
at 4 PM took a fresh N.E. gale

first of N.W. Wind & pleasant weather ship heading

Saturday February 4 1871

Strong N.W. wind & pleasant weather  
Ship heading to the N.W. by the Wind

Lat 48° 41' N

Long 74° 20' W

Monday February 20 1871

fine weather with fine breeze from  
S.E. I think the clouds had calmed & light  
westerly wind for the first week

Lat 26° 30' Long 71° 39'
