Latter Part Thick And Rainy at 5 made Sail Wind SSW and Light Heading West at 10 Lighted up bore ship to the East ward Saw the Barque Kora on our Weather Bear So Ends these 24 Hours

Friday May the 19 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Light Winds from the S E Heading East at 2 O'clock Wind S West Heading WSW Caught 2 Porpoises at 7 O'clock Shorten Sail Heading WSW

Middle Part Calm With A Heavy Tempest

Latter Part Calm Thick and Rainy Saw nothing So Ends these 24 Hours

Commencement of these 24 Hours Calm at 2 O'clock Light Breeze from the South and Rainy at 4 O'clock Saw Black fish Lard found which could not get on come on board to look for more at 7 Shorten Sail Heading S E

Middle Part Pleasant

Latter Part Light Breeze WSW Heading to the S Westward Saw the Barque Kora under our Lee Boiling at 8 O'clock touch in the Stream Thermometer 74 at 9 O'clock Tack Ship So Ends these 24 H
